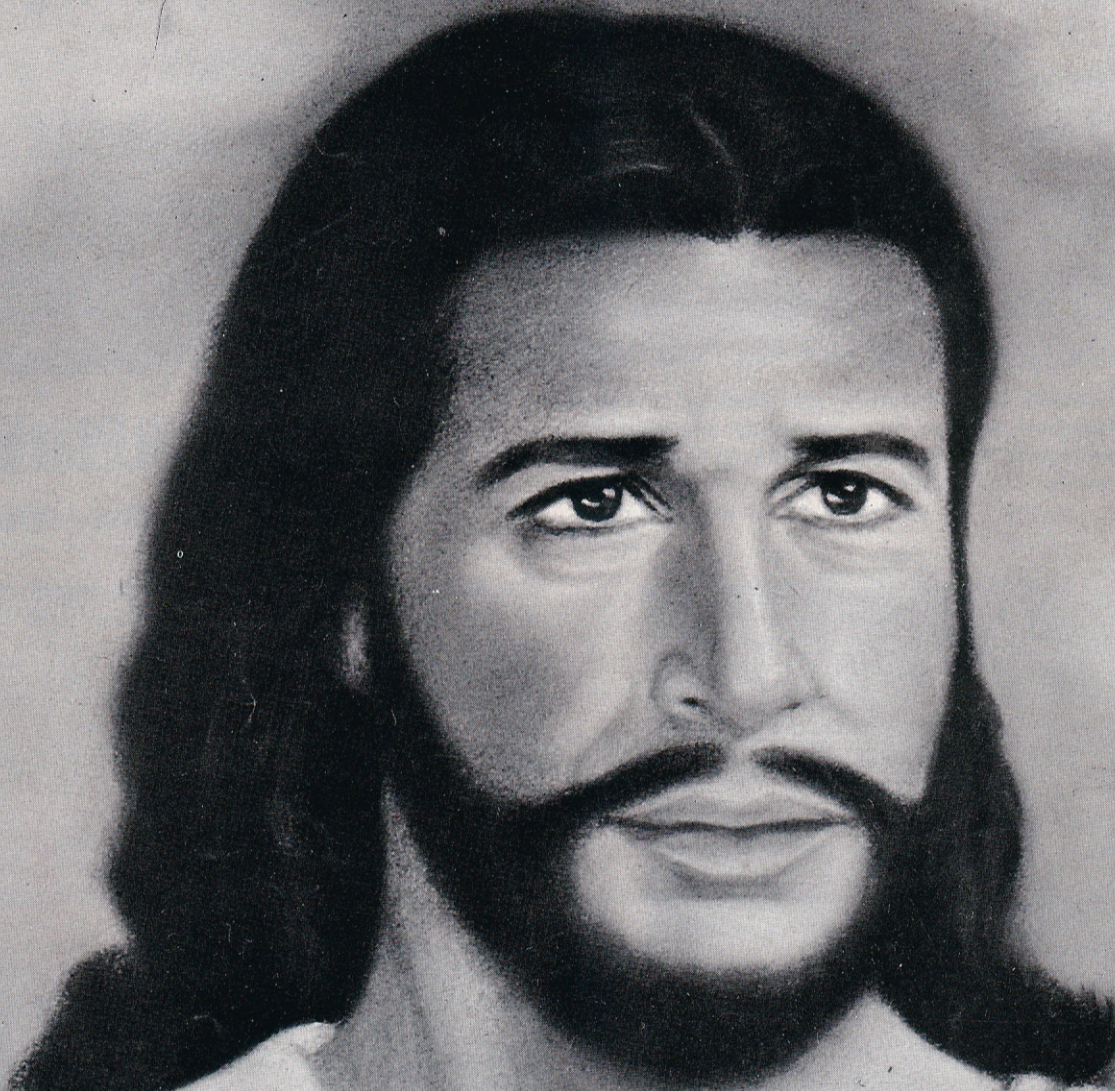

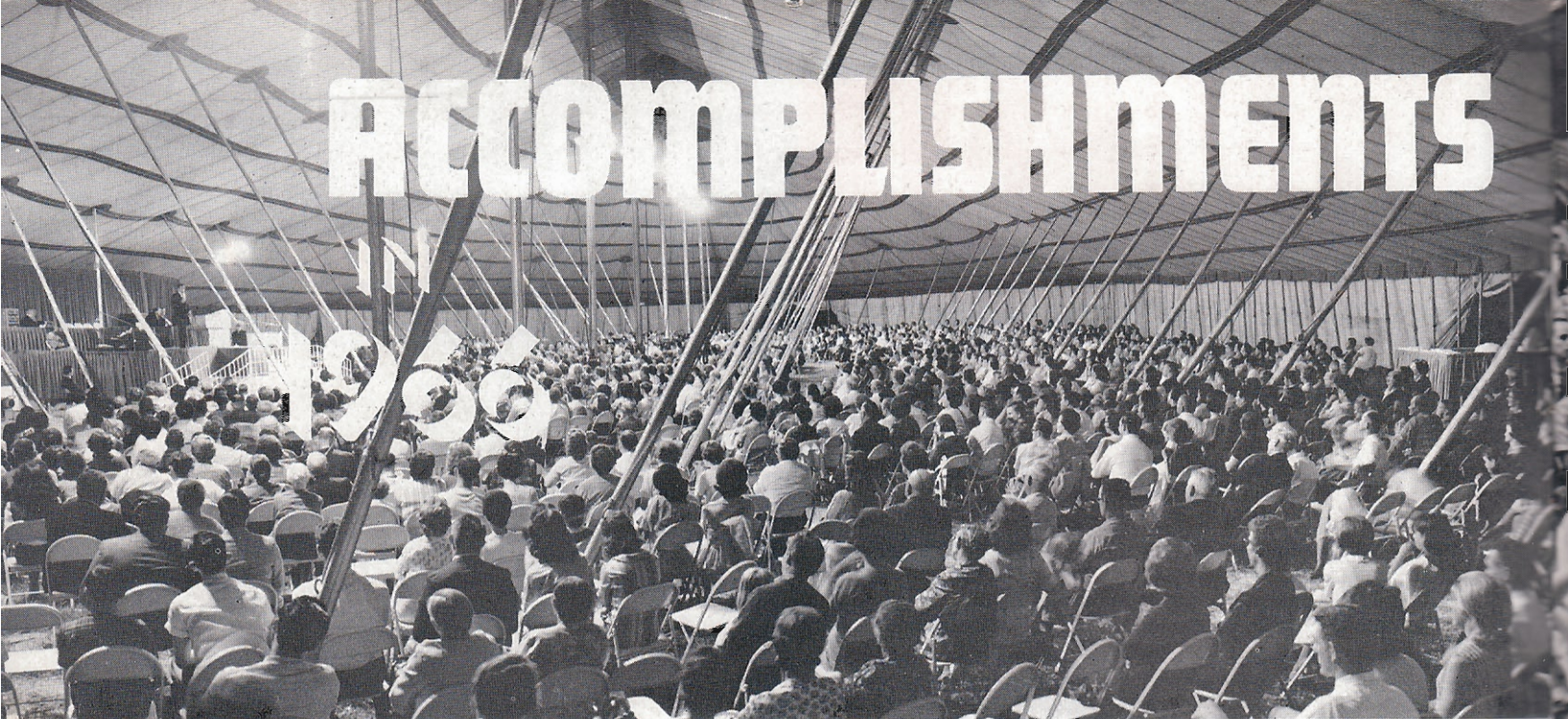

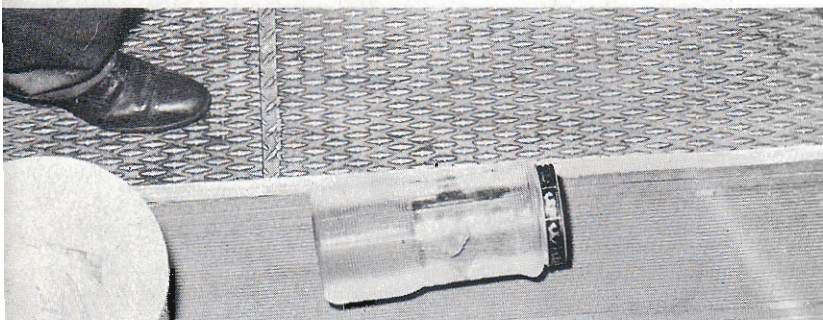

LIVING CLOSE



ow often do you long for a place to hide when the problems of life seem unbearable?

It is then that you need a haven of safety where you can escape the storm. How often do you try to paint the clouds with sunshine. . . but inside your heart is secretly crying? It is then that you need to hear those reassuring words, "CASTING YOUR CARE ON HIM, FOR HE CARETH FOR YOU."

It is impossible but that offenses must come, and all must suffer the stings of a cruel world. But there is a place of refuge — a place where we can find sympathy and understanding, and someone to bind up our wounds. I have found One who will never walk away from your faintest cry; One who meant it when He said, "Come unto me all ye that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest."

Growing up in this world calls for a lot of bumps and knocks. We must grow into strong men and women, so the Lord allows trials to come our way to help us develop. As the blacksmith shapes the iron by heating, so our Heavenly Father fashions our souls during these emotional stresses. More than an earthly father guides his son with arms of love, does our Heavenly Father share with us those moments of caress and tender affection. We need but to find a quiet place and invite Him in. Jesus said, "Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me." And the joy you share as you linger there shall be a treasure to your soul.

A friend of mine visited in the East and related to me the beautiful process of growing rice. It is first sown on a morass of mud and water, and after a few weeks it springs up and appears above the water with its beautiful pale green shoots. The plants are sown thickly and then comes the process of transplanting. God, at first, allows us to grow closely to some of His children but then comes the time that we must be transplanted.

We are at first in the nursery of gentle care, but then His Spirit calls us into situations where we have to lean more directly on Him. He puts upon us the weight of responsibility and we are thrown upon the great resources of His grace. "Blessed is the man that trusteth in the Lord, and whose hope the Lord is. For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and that spreadeth out her roots by the river."

There are two ways we can face our trials. One is to simply try to escape them and be thankful when they are over. The other is to recognize the trial as a challenge from God to claim a larger blessing than we have ever had, and to hail it with delight and an opportunity of obtaining a larger measure of divine grace. When God tests you it is a good time for you to test Him by putting His promises to the proof, and claiming from Him just as much as your trials have rendered necessary.

How do we gain strength from the Lord? How do we acquire the mastery over our problems? The psalmist said, "Wait on the Lord." How often this is said in the Bible and how little we understand it! The old monk called it "practicing the presence of God." It is forming the habit of prayer. It is the continued communion that not only asks, but receives. Our hearts are too fragile to take in His fullness at a single breath, so we must live in the atmosphere of His presence till we absorb His very life. This is the secret of spiritual depth and rest, of power and fullness, of love, hope and holy usefulness. "Wait, I say, on the Lord."

*I am waiting in communion at the blessed mercy seat;
I am waiting, sweetly waiting, on the Lord;
I am drinking of His fullness; I am sitting at His feet;
I am hearkening to the whispers of His Word.*

Why struggle along day after day with the burdens of life weighing down upon you? God is more than a match for any problem, and He has promised to take your cares away. Didn't He say, "Cast your cares upon Me?" He said that His yoke is easy and His burden is light.

To live close to God is to see God in everything. A child once came to his dad and said, "Papa, look at that golden sign across the street a good while; now look at that brick wall and tell me what you see." "Why, I see the golden sign on the brick wall." The little child laughed merrily over it. So, if we look a long time upon Jesus we cannot look at anything else without seeing a reflection of Him. Everything which we behold will become a part of Him.

Purity and victory are closely related. God gives us power to stand in holy vigilance. His Spirit will enable our conscience to detect and deflect the darts of evil which would poison our souls.

Let us be quick to take every pressure as a call to prayer. This is a thing which we may learn to enjoy — each prayer one round higher; each difficulty a greater occasion for prayer. We should rejoice that God considers us worthy of His attention; that He is willing to make an effort to prepare us as His everlasting companion; that He has gone to such great length to qualify us for His eternal fellowship.

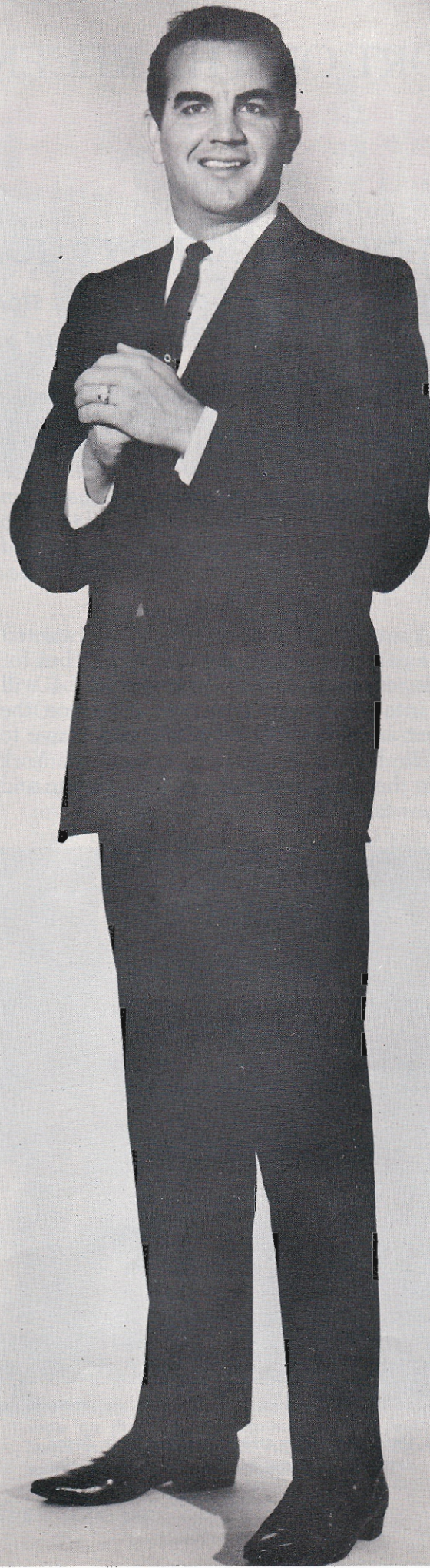
I know the struggles you have in your heart, for no one escapes the fight for survival. I know what it is to abound and to be abased. Someone else knows every heartache you bear. Jesus learned obedience by sharing these same trials for He refused to have it any other way. I believe He felt a surge of togetherness when He could show Thomas the scars in His hands and in His side. Jesus wants to be near us so much that He left home and became one of us. There will never be any estrangement between us and our Master for we have eaten from the same bowl; walked the same dusty roads; endured the same heartaches. We shall feel at home with Him wherever it is.

Closeness to Christ means ministering to Him. Are you ministering with your heart; your hands; your substance? Does He have a place at your table? In His absence is it free to His representative; His children? Words and wishes are cheap if they don't find expression in actual deeds. A lady who had promised a costly offering for the Master's work was asked, "Can you afford it?" "No," was her noble reply, "but I can sacrifice it." Our words must be backed by our actions.

Whatever you must turn loose, hold fast to your trust in God. And while holding your trust, hold your sweetness, your rightness of spirit, your obedience to God and your victory in Christ. The apostolic disciples considered it an honor to be counted worthy to suffer persecution for the gospel of Jesus. So let's count it a challenge to come up higher each time God allows us to fall into a trial.

To experience a real closeness with God we must consent to the destruction of the self-life. God can come into our inner being only when we resolve our own will to His. Self must be replaced by the Spirit of Christ. Usually the spiritual crisis in life hangs on a single point. People hedge and dodge to keep God from striking a death blow to their besetting sin until they settle into a state of compromise. There is one point that touches the heart, and that is the point God usually strikes. It is the dearest thing in life, the decisive thing in our plans, the citadel of the will, the center of the heart; and when we yield there, there is little left to yield anywhere else. To settle this area once and for all is to save a lot of useless pain.

How can one describe the splendor of Rome, the city whose memories have filled the pages of our history books. As we walked into the ruins of the famous old Colosseum, the gold lighting created a glow which cast its shadow over the cages where the wild animals were turned loose upon the Christians. As I saw the platform where the royal family sat to laugh at the fate of those who wouldn't deny Christ, I could hear the roar of the crowd, as they waited for the chariot races to begin. Our two days in Rome were filled with haunting memories.

After leaving Rome we arrived in Beirut, Lebanon. We awoke the next morning to hear the Mediterranean Sea gently rolling into the sandy shoreline. What a briskness there was in the air as we began our tour of this famous

landmark, exploring the quaint shops along the streets. Then out into the open country we stopped to get a better view of the ancient cedars of Lebanon, from which Solomon erected the first temple in Israel. Our afternoon was spent in the exploration of the famous old temple ruins in the little town of Byblos. Christianity named its Holy Book, the Bible, after Byblos, whose name means papyrus or book.

Can you imagine yourself standing in the temple, which the enemy later dedicated to Jupiter, and fail to wonder how such architecture could be erected 1300 years before Christ. As you gaze up the mammoth columns, measuring 69 feet in height and weighing hundreds of tons, it seems impossible that such materials could have been transported from Egypt in that time.

At sunrise, the next morning, all of our LJEAs were on their way by bus to Damascus, Syria. What a thrill to walk down the street called "straight," into the house of Ananias where Paul received his sight. We had a devotional service there, and as Brother Jenkins recalled the story of a man who yielded his life as completely to God as he had once to Satan, you could almost see the scene once again. It's so hard to explain Damascus because there was such a feeling of the past. The Moslem wives still wore their black veils, and it seemed as if you might pass the apostle Paul on the street at any time.

My fondest memory was visiting a Greek Orthodox orphanage on the site where St. Paul was lowered over the wall in a basket. As we were visiting with the children and nuns, the Lord spoke to Brother Jenkins to pray for the

children and sisters individually and to receive an offering for them. As we began to give, God melted our hearts and we began to cry. Our beloved guide, Jesse, who was a born-again Christian, bowed over the stair railing and began to weep like a child. He put his arms around *Brother Jenkins* and said, "Oh, my brother, you will never know what you have done here." They were so grateful that

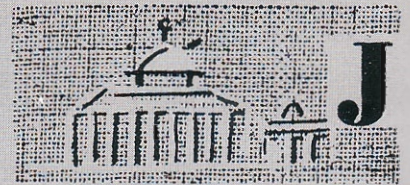
even though we were not of their faith, we loved those children and responded generously.

How could we visit Bethany without seeing the home of Mary, Martha and Lazarus? and then on to the Dead Sea, where we just had to go wading. Even though we were only a short distance from Jerusalem, we enjoyed many pleasant hours. Whether it was a few quiet moments in the Garden of Gethsemane or standing on the Mount of Olives viewing the gate called Beautiful, I always felt a part of another era; as if I had been drawn back into the pages of history.

I must share with you the sermon on the Mount of Olives. The television cameras were rolling as *Brother Jenkins'* special partners sat on the hillside slope overlooking Jerusalem. *Brother Jenkins*, in a black robe, spoke from his heart, and then we had communion. As he began to minister to the partners, villagers began stopping to see what God was doing. In a short time many people gathered, believing God for their deliverance. After that, God's spirit moved in such a powerful way that it stirred the entire city as scores of people were

How To Keep The Joy

The Power of Pentecost is not given just to tickle the souls of the saints. If the sum total of your baptism in the Holy Ghost is just for your own joy and edification, then you are off the beam to start with. Jesus said we should receive that our joy shall be full; but that is only to get under way in the experience of Pentecost. Our Blessed Lord likened the baptism that He would give to a river that must be constantly flowing out. If this outward flow does not continue, soon there is no river to pour out of the soul to bless others. Even a purified soul can thus become mighty dry and useless.

Why Is The Holy Ghost Given?

You know that when one enters into the charismatic experience he becomes a partner with Christ in the great enterprise of seeking and saving the lost.

So far the church has almost failed in going into all the world to make disciples of every creature. People are being born faster than souls are being saved in our world right now.

Not Many Apostles

It is indeed wonderful to be used by God in apostolic fashion as a few are today in reaching thousands for Christ. All of us would be thrilled to be a LeRoy Jenkins, a Billy Graham, or an Oral Roberts. But such apostolic labor is only achieved by a small number. That was true in the early Christian era; it is true today. We should count it a great privilege under God to be a Partner of Brother Jenkins in his great work. Have you tasted the joy of winning someone to the Lord? If you will add to that joy by winning another as quickly as possible, you will be a veritable fountain of blessing in this wicked generation.

You may say, "I don't know how to witness to others, or I am afraid to try." Love for the lost that burns in your soul will find a way. The Holy Spirit will make your feeble effort effective and fruitful.

The Parable of The Octopus

Don't be like a certain young man. Have you heard about him? While out on a date, he said to his girl, "I wish I was an octopus." She wanted to know about that octopus. He told her that it was a creature way down in the sea that had a lot of long arms. "What would you do if you were an octopus with all those long arms?" When he told her that he would hug her with every last one of 'em; she said, "Why do you want eight arms when you aren't even using the two you already have."

What a parable! Are we using what we do have in witnessing to others. Are we even trying to witness? Are we praying that God will help us to be "Fishers of Men"? If not, then no wonder that the joy and glory is gone. The Pentecostal stream has about dried up, because we have not shared our joy and experience with others. 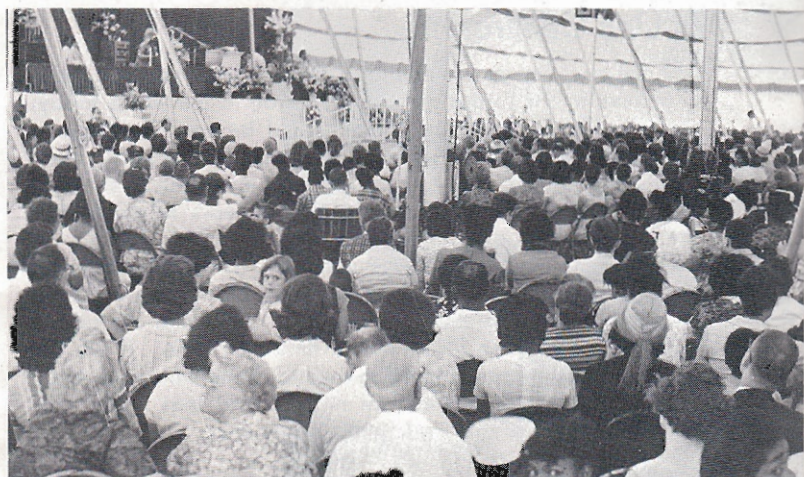

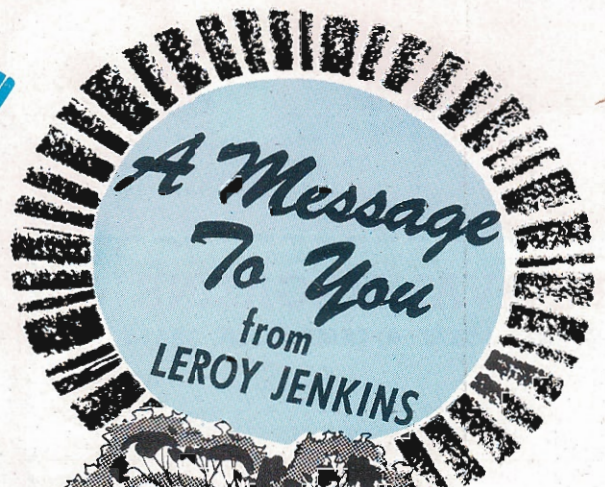

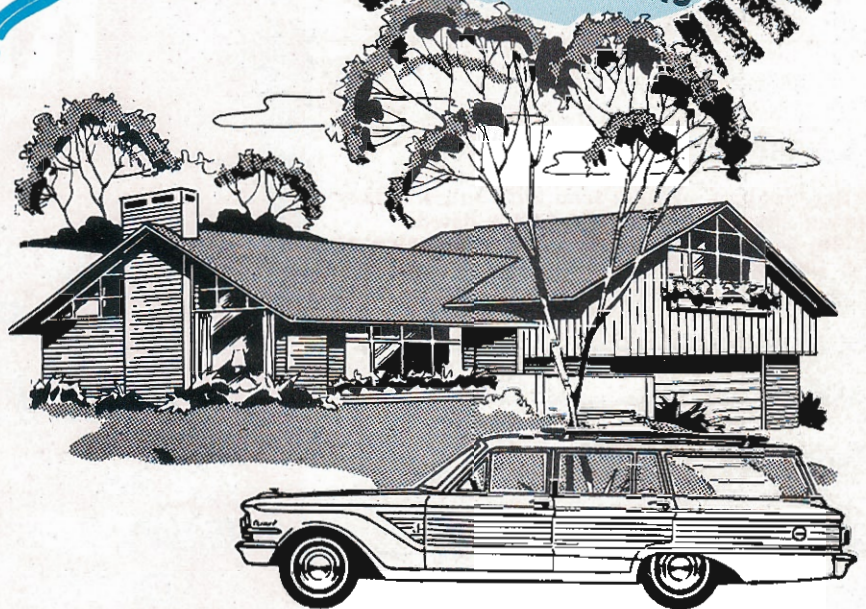
