

word that we find throughout the book of Revelation is "overcome." This word is a definite command from the throne of God. We must be "overcomers" daily for Him. In Ephesians 5, Paul tells us to "put on the whole armor of God, that we may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil." Have you noticed that the armor he described protects mainly in the front? Doesn't that suggest to you that we must be continuously moving forward as "overcomers"?

If we relax spiritually for one moment, satan can catch us off guard. This takes a lot of training on our part to keep ourselves spiritually fit for service. I sincerely believe that spiritual weakness has been a major cause of physical sickness. I know in my ministry I must daily exercise my faith in God because I know that many times I would have been defeated in His purpose for my life if I failed to do so. You may be saying, "Well, with all the problems in my life, this seems almost impossible." I know that the devil will prey on your mind – he will put fear on you if he can. He will make you afraid

that you are going to die – that you will never get rid of that disease! He will make you think that you are never going to be delivered, that loved one is never going to be saved, or that you will be poor and in poverty the rest of your life! You can go through life with a long face saying, "Nothing good is ever going to happen to me here on earth, but maybe someday, somewhere, somehow, everything will be okay." And you will be exactly right. Nothing good is ever going to happen to you here on earth. You are going to be sick, tired and defeated every day of your life if you will not accept any of God's promises on faith.

You have to see it before you believe it. Well, the Bible says BELIEVE IT AND THEN YOU WILL SEE IT! It's time we started trusting God and believing His Word instead of everything else — everything we feel or hear — every circumstance the devil is able to change. HOW ARE YOU GOING TO ENDURE TO THE END IF YOU DON'T BELIEVE GOD? Some of you just go right on doing the same thing

over and over again. You say Amen and sometimes you shout Hallelujah! But you believe everything the devil says instead of what God says.

Now God doesn't need someone to go on and on, over and over again about the same thing. The devil has got thousands of people doing that. He wants someone who will believe his word and act accordingly. You can keep on praying for something until the cows come home if you want to, but God hears you the FIRST TIME. Your prayer is answered when you pray if you believe what God says in His Word. And if you do not believe, you can pray about the same thing until you are blue in the face, but it will not do you a bit of good.

Do you realize there are thousands of people in the world who are church members who would be lost if the Lord were to come today because they do not believe what God says? They have been taught, or trained, or raised in a certain religion, and because their mother, father, husband or wife believe a certain way, that is the way they believe too. They

won't believe the Bible, but they will believe everything else.

I would like to tell you of an experience I had several years ago during a crusade I was conducting in Daytona Beach, Florida. It was a near defeat. Through physical fatigue, I had contracted a very infectious disease. A close friend of mine, who is a medical doctor, told me that I was going to have to discontinue my ministry of evangelism or drop dead at any time. I had heard the expression from a dear old saint one time that went something like this, "I'm not a'gonna rust out, I'm a'gonna burn out for my Lord." Well, you know how I feel about this ministry - I intend to "burn out" too. I took spiritual inventory of my life. and I knew that if God did take me home, I was ready to go. Then I started checking on my attitude towards the ministry and the people I came in contact with personally and in meetings. I was shocked to face the reality that I had let my guard down. Many problems and burdens were facing me, as they usually do with anyone in this type of ministry. Somehow, I had

allowed people to "get to me" and their attitudes and negative ideas had rubbed off on me.


I carefully traced this back to the time this illness had come upon me; and sure enough, I had found the source of my trouble. I had stopped being the overcomer that God wanted me to be. I guess you think that after I discovered my condition that I braced my shoulders, gritted my teeth and started back on the right foot again. Well, you are wrong. I had allowed myself to get to the place and say aloud to God, "Take me home, Lord. I've had it!" But God wouldn't put up with this because He had called me to a particular job and He was going to make sure that I did that job. I had become so weak that I could hardly stand before a congregation. Just before service time one night, the Lord spoke to me and told me that He was going to heal me right then and there. Power and strength surged through my body greater than I had ever experienced before. I went to the service that night and preached and ministered until long after midnight. This was the second greatest miracle of my

life! Praise His Wonderful Name!

I am sharing this personal experience with you to show you how the devil fights and tries to defeat us, and also how God takes control of our lives even when there is no will of our own left to defend and overcome. This experience has become a great light of warning to me. We need to always be aware of the satanic pitfalls that are surrounding us at all times.


God is trying to speak to you today. He wants you to believe what He says, because if you don't, then you will not last. The only way to defeat the devil is be standing on God's Word. When the devil realizes that you are standing firmly on the Word of God, then he and all his hosts will flee. You will be delivered by God!

God has admonished us to be "faithful unto death", and the only way I know how to do this is to be an overcomer daily. God's Word tells us to "take no thought for tomorrow", but to take one day at a time. I trust that you will take this hint from my experience, and that you, too, will be an "overcomer" for Him.


Christmas began early on the morning of December 24th when I received a phone call from Rev. Jenkins' office advising that he would be able to spend the evening of February 11th on our island of Maui in conjunction with the Hawaiian crusade scheduled for February 13 in Waikiki, Hawaii, on the island of Oahu. I originally had written Rev. Jenkins earlier in December, as a representative of our local Maui Chapter of the Full Gospel Business Men's

Fellowship, to suggest a service on Maui. Not knowing if a Maui visit might be worked into his trip, since crusade plans, schedules and preparations must be made far in advance, we turned all this over to the Lord for His perfect plan.

Praise God that all things are possible with God and the way was made clear for Rev. Jenkins to come to Maui. Anticipation of the service was high in the community and all planning and preparations fell perfectly in place as God directed. The evening of the service resulted in our auditorium being filled to overflowing, which has rarely

occurred for any event and I feel sure has never happened here before for a service glorifying God.

The service was a glorious time of praising God and being in the Spirit as Rev. Jenkins brought God's message and was used mightily by the Lord in the performance of many miracles of healing to body, spirit and soul. We saw the crippled leave the wheel chair, ears opened and pain relieved as Christ's Aloha was ministered. Hearts opened and salvation came as many troubled young people accepted Rev. Jenkin's invitation to come forward and accept Christ.




In the time since the service, the glow of the Spirit has shone brightly in reports from local ministers telling us of people now attending their churches who met Christ for the first time through the service. Some of these people had been Buddhists as there is a large Oriental population on Maui.

All of Rev. Jenkin's friends here eagerly await his return and ministry and until then, are uplifted and encouraged through the weekly "Revival of America" telecast. Our only concern is to have a facility large enough for the next crusade, but we know, as always, the Lord will provide the perfect place at the right time.

#### **CHUCK FAUGHT, KONA, HAWAII**

In the four years as president of the Full Gospel Business Men's Association the Leroy Jenkins Crusade held on Kona last month drew the largest crowd to ever attend a religious meeting here. The 1,800 people represented nearly four times the amount who usually come. I saw more people miraculously healed than I had ever seen and more people accepted the Lord than I had ever seen.

The people are waiting for Leroy Jenkins to return to these islands of Buddhism and pagan gods and ministers who do so little to combat false religions.

On 13 February, 1977 you appeared at the Waikiki Shell in Honolulu. You laid you hand upon my wife Faith (she had rheumatoid arthritis — the excrutiatingly painful kind for five long years) and healed her!

Faith and I are thinking of the story of the ten lepers who had been healed by Jesus (Luke 12:12) but only one returned to give thanks to the Lord. Ergo, this letter.

You probably don't remember us, Reverend Jenkins, but we will never forget the event. Faith was sitting in her wheelchair way over to your right under a small palm tree, barely able to see you on center-stage. It was 7 p.m. You were closing down your one-day crusade in Honolulu. You had sung your last song. You had said your final "thank-you's". The TV camera was off. The band was picking up their instruments. The huge crowd of about 10,000 was beginning to disperse. You put down your microphone and started to exit towards the right wing of the sprawling stage that was the Waikiki Shell.

At that moment it happened. Through a hundred feet of intervening space, your eyes met my wife's. Just for one brief instant.

never explain in logic. You headed . . . not for the exit . . . but straight for my wife. Somehow you knew! You knew she had been waiting three long hours to catch your eye. You knew she needed healing. You knew she was ready to receive her healing. Surrounded as she was by others in wheelchairs, on crutches and canes and braces, she was veritably lost in the














crowd. She was already thinking she didn't have a chance for a miracle healing that day. Maybe next time, she thought, if and when you come to Hawaii again.

Now while we are living in the mortal body, this earthly


