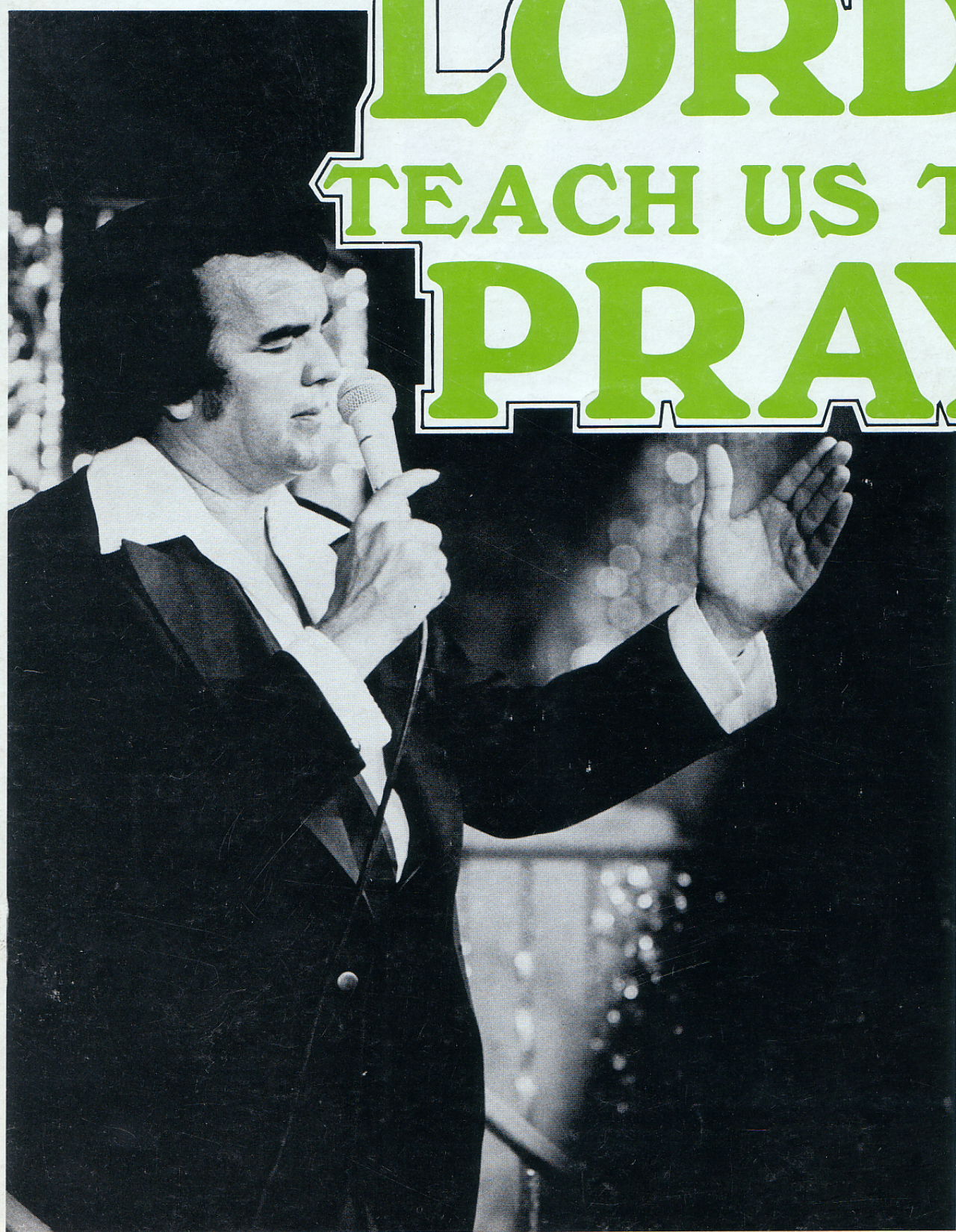

LORD, TEACH US TO PRAY

I receive many letters each day from people who say they have prayed and prayed about a thing, but nothing ever seems to happen. I am inclined to believe that perhaps they are not praying according to the way God tells us to pray in His Word. Even the disciples had to ask Jesus how to pray. (*Luke 11:1*)

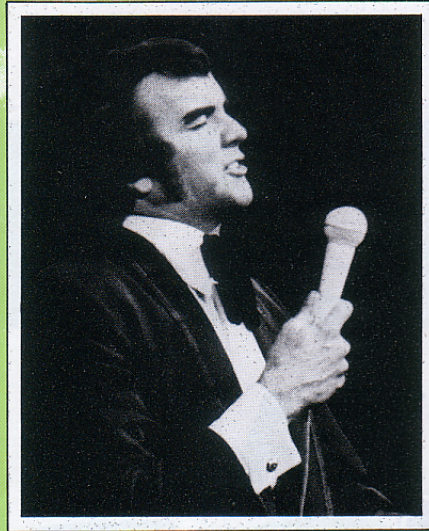
The Lord's Prayer

Jesus Christ gave us an example of prayer when the disciples asked Him how to pray. "After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen." (*Matt 6:9-13*)

Many people recognize this as the Lord's Prayer, but few people realize all that it says. Millions of people repeat this prayer in churches all across the country, but most never really understand what they are praying. In this example of prayer set forth by Jesus Christ, we are told to whom we should pray, for what we should pray, and how we should pray.

To Whom Should We Pray?

When we pray, we are to pray to God, our heavenly Father. He is the only One who can hear and answer our prayers. He holds all the power of the universe in His hands. And it surely makes sense that we should pray to the One who created the earth and



everything in it, for since He is the creator, then He surely is the sustainer of all life. "Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, that the everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? there is no searching of his understanding." (*Isaiah 40:28*)

How Should We Pray?

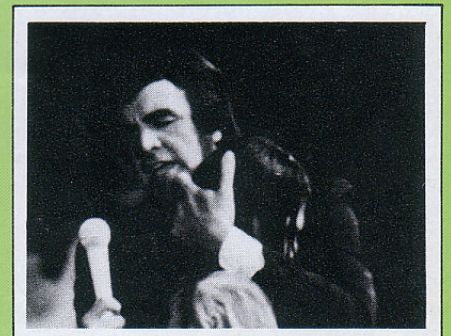
Prayer is an important part of the Christian life. Even Jesus Christ, the Son of God, recognized the need to pray. Many times throughout His life it is recorded in the Bible where He prayed and asked for strength and guidance. After He ate the feast of the passover He went into the garden to pray, for He already knew what was about to take place. (*Luke 26*) He prayed for God's will to be done in His life. Many times we become selfish and think only of ourselves and of what we want, but God must have the glory in all things.

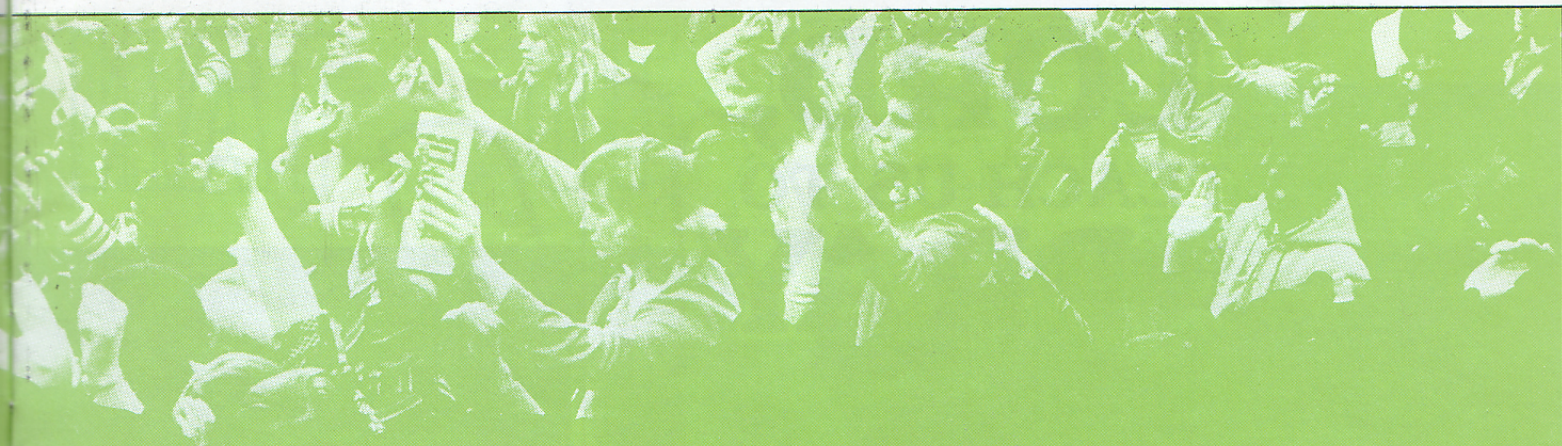
When we pray, we should not use vain repetitions. I don't believe we have to pray over and over about a thing before God will answer. He hears and answers our prayers the first time we believe Him for an answer. And I don't believe we need to pray long, drawn-out prayers. God knows everything we have need of, and He isn't impressed by our big

words and long prayers. He tells us that "The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much." (*James 5:16*)

We need to come to God the same as a little child would go to their father and ask for something — in faith believing. "If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if he ask a fish, will he for a fish give him a serpent? Or if he shall ask an egg, will he offer him a scorpion?" (*Luke 11:11,12*) We should pray in faith believing. In order to become a Christian, we must come to God as a little child, and in order to get our prayers answered once we become a Christian, we must have child-like faith. "Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them." (*Mark 11:24*)

Prayer is our way of communicating with God. Our prayers are personal, between God and us. Jesus warned us not to be like the hypocrites when we pray — standing out in public and praying to be seen of men. God doesn't answer that kind of prayer, for they have already received their reward. Rather, He tells us, "But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door,





pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly." (*Matt 6:6*)

We need to have a forgiving spirit if we expect God to forgive us and answer our prayers. "And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses." (*Mark 11:25, 26*) He even went so far as to say, "Therefore if thou bring thy gift to the altar, and there rememberest that thy brother hath ought against thee; Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift." (*Matt 5:23, 24*) When Peter asked the Lord if seven times was enough to forgive someone who trespassed against him, Jesus replied, "I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven." (*Matt 18:22*) God so freely forgives us of our sins and shows us mercy when we ask Him to do so, and He expects us to just as freely forgive those who do wrong to us.

For What Should We Pray?

In the Lord's Prayer, Jesus tells us what we should pray for when He says, "Give us this day our daily bread." (*Matt 6:11*) We should only be concerned about the needs of today and not worry about tomorrow or the next day. But many times we are tricked into worrying about the future.

We should recognize this for what it is — a trick of the enemy — and realize that we have power over the enemy. Christ told us, "Greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world." (*1 John 4:4*)

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus tells us to "take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment? Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they? Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature? And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin: And yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory

we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof." (*Matt 6:25-34*) From this Scripture, we can see that God wants us to take one day at a time, and pray for the needs of that day. He will do the rest.

When we pray, we are to pray for God's protection and deliverance from evil. Jesus repeatedly told His disciples, "Pray that ye enter not into temptation." (*Luke 22:40*) Many people feel that God tempts them. But God tells us in His Word, "Let no man say when he is tempted, I

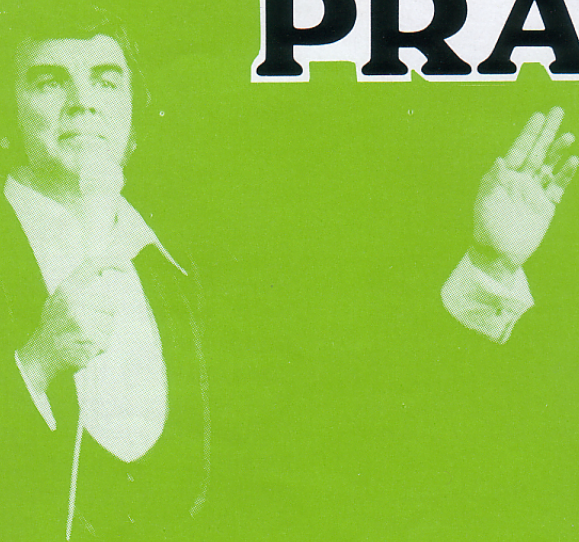


was not arrayed like one of these. Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith? Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall

am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man: But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed." (*James 1:13, 14*) We cannot stop temptations from

being put before us. It is the job of the enemy to tempt us. Even Jesus Christ was tempted when He fasted 40 days and nights in the wilderness. But He overcame the temptation by using the Word of God. We can also overcome the temptations we encounter every day. God tells us, "There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able: but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it." (I Cor 10:13)

Thank The Lord For Answering Your Prayers

When we pray we must be careful to give God the glory for all things. He is a jealous God, and doesn't like for credit to be given to anyone or anything else. He alone wants our love and praise. "Thou shalt not make thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the waters beneath the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself unto them, nor serve them: for I the Lord thy God am

a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me, And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me and keep my commandments." (Deut 5:8-10)

Prayer and praise go hand in hand. When we pray, we should accept the answer by faith and believe that God heard and answered our prayer. We should thank Him in advance for the answer, for when we pray according to His will, He always answers our prayers. He is our heavenly Father and He always wants the best for us. "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth." (III John 2) His promises are for us today. All we have to do is accept them by faith.

"Our Father, which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen."

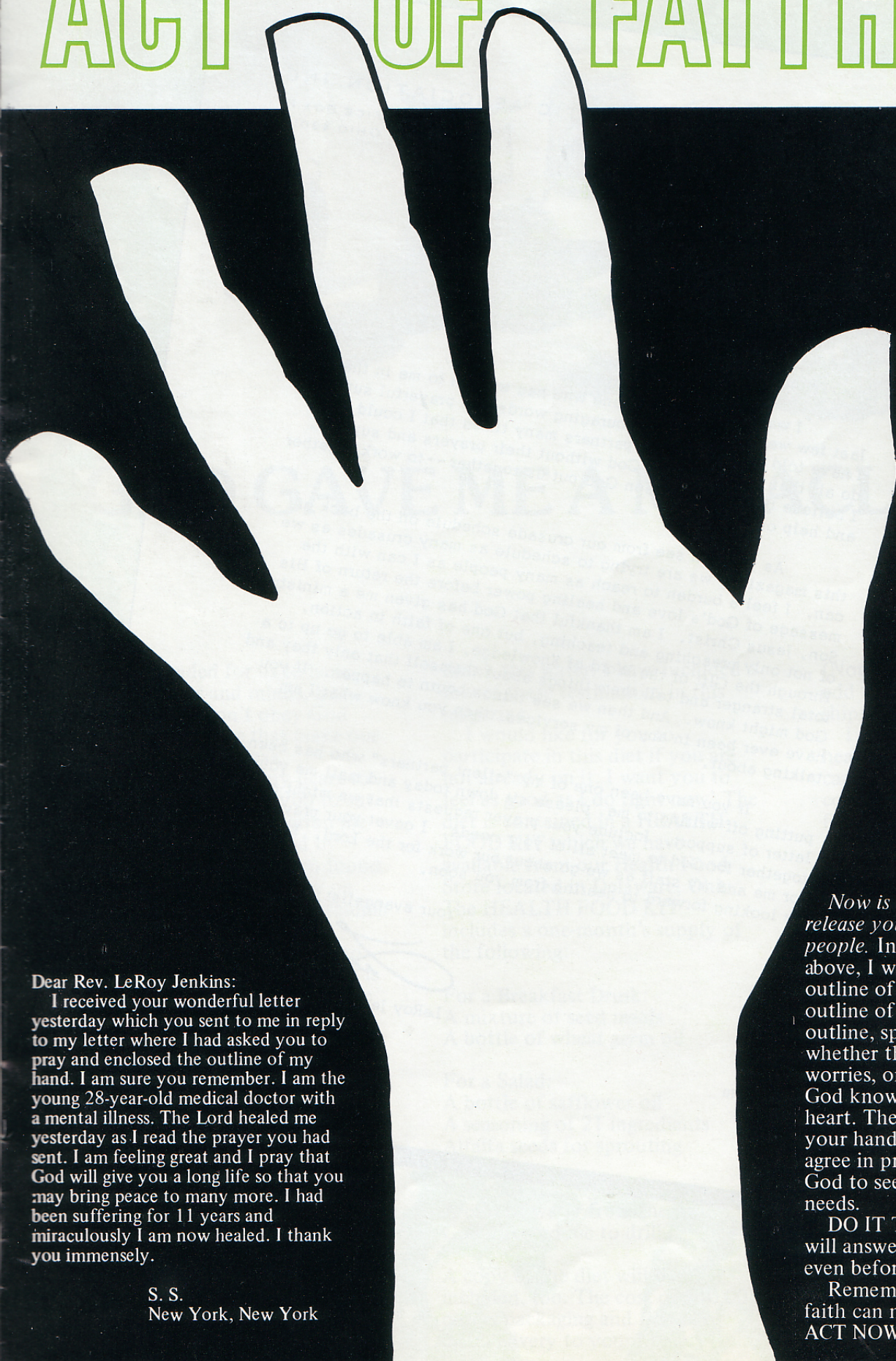

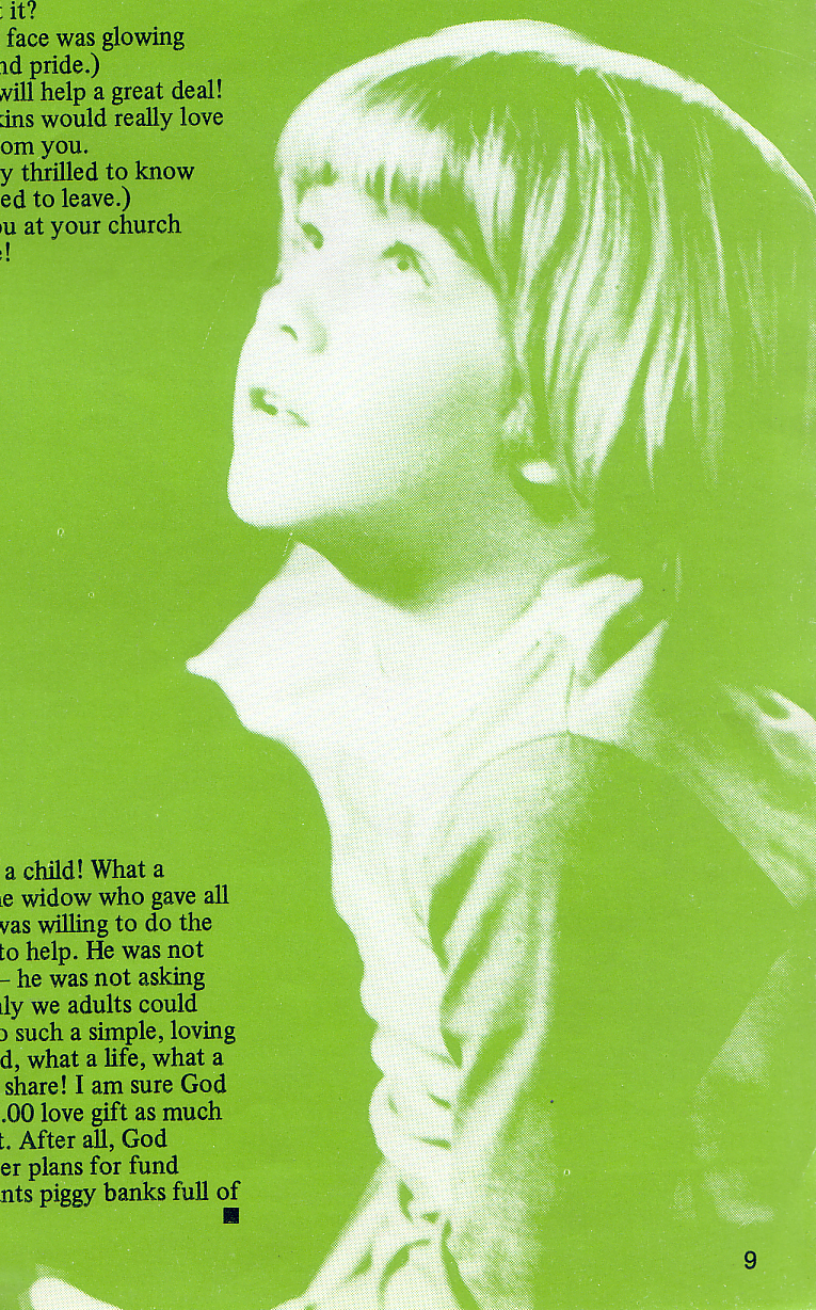
(By now the boy's face was glowing with excitement and pride.)

Crusade

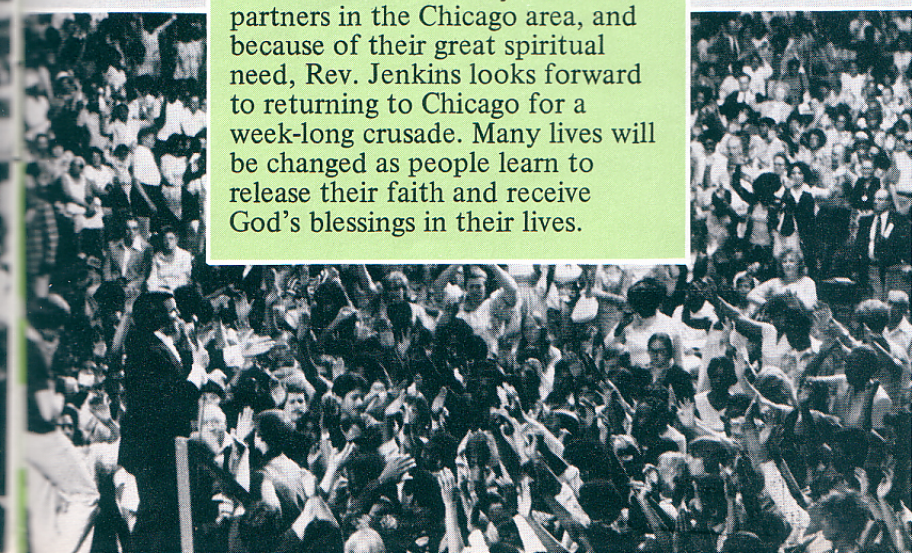
REPORT

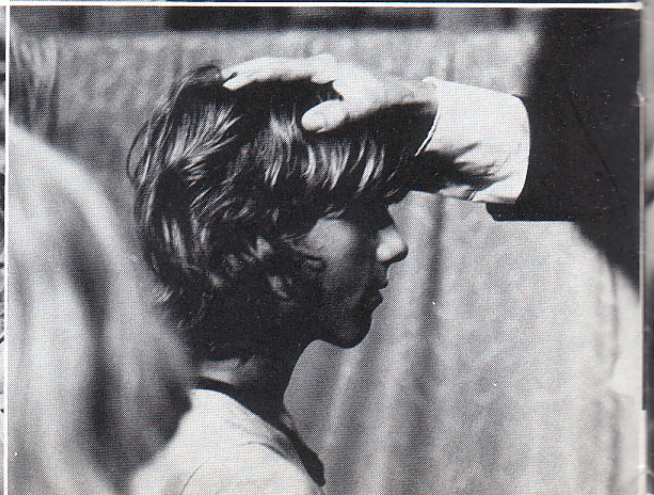
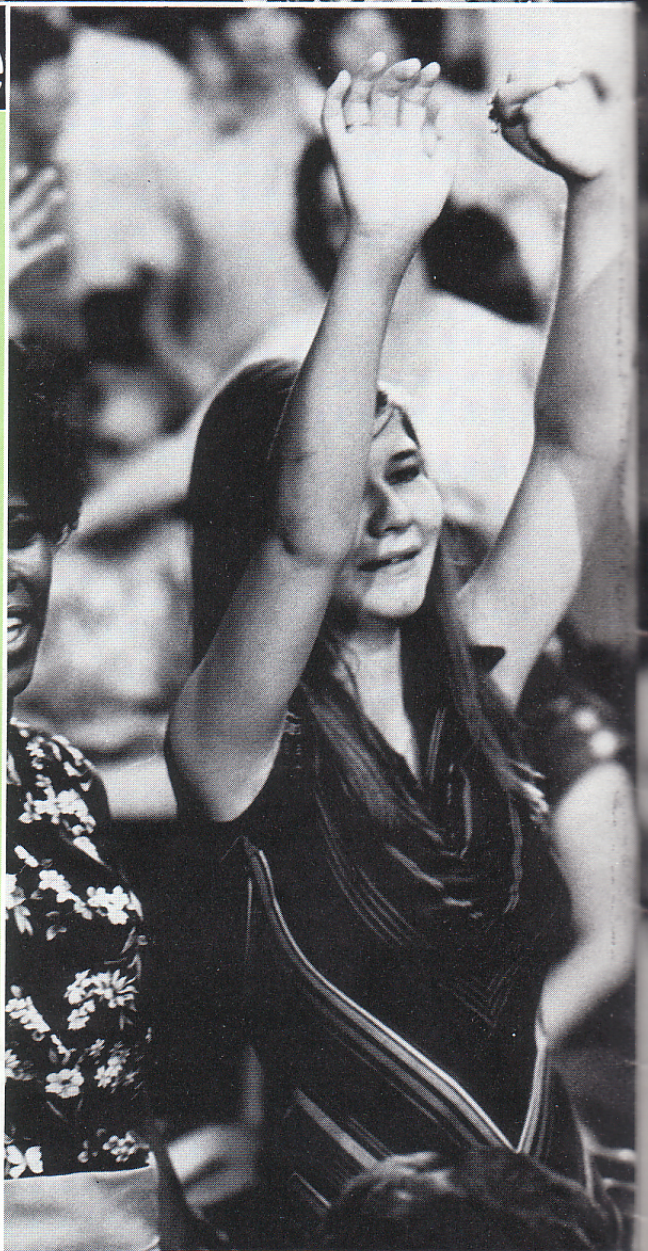
Crusade REPORT

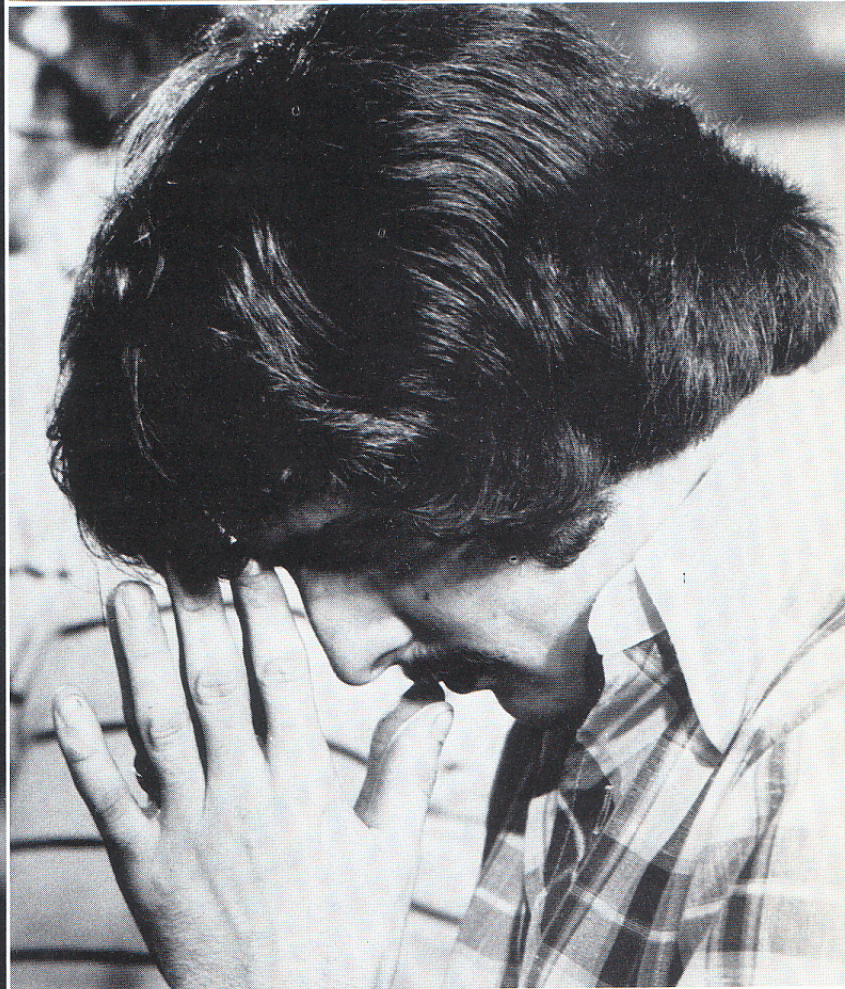
CINCINNATI, OHIO

FASTING

Fasting should be an important part of every Christian's life. Fasting and prayer go hand in hand. There are many examples in the Bible of fasting. When Esther was about to go before the king and plead her people's cause, she knew the power and strength that would come from fasting when she said, "Go, gather together all the Jews that are present in Shushan, and fast ye for me, and neither eat nor drink three days, night or day: I also and my maidens will fast likewise . . ." (*Esther 4:16*)

Jesus Christ Himself left us an example to follow when He went into the wilderness and prayed and fasted 40 days and nights. This was during the early part of His ministry, and He knew He needed strength and guidance for the work God had given Him to do.

The importance of prayer and fasting can be seen when God tells us that some things can only come about through prayer and fasting. When the disciples asked Christ why they could not heal the lunatic, He said unto them, "Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you. Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting." (*Matt 17:20, 21*)

How Should We Fast?

God tells us in His Word how we should go about fasting. "Moreover when ye fast, be not, as the hypocrites, of a sad countenance: for they disfigure their faces, that they may appear unto men to fast. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward. But thou, when thou fastest, anoint thine head, and wash thy face; That thou appear not unto

men to fast, but unto thy Father which is in secret: and thy Father, which seeth in secret, shall reward thee openly." (*Matt 6:16-18*)

When you feel led to fast, it is between you and God. You should not tell anyone, because then you already have your reward.

For What Should We Fast?

God tells us about the fast He approves of in Isaiah 58:6, 7 when He says, "Is not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke? Is it not to deal thy bread to the hungry, and that thou bring the poor that are cast out to thy house? when thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and that thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh?"

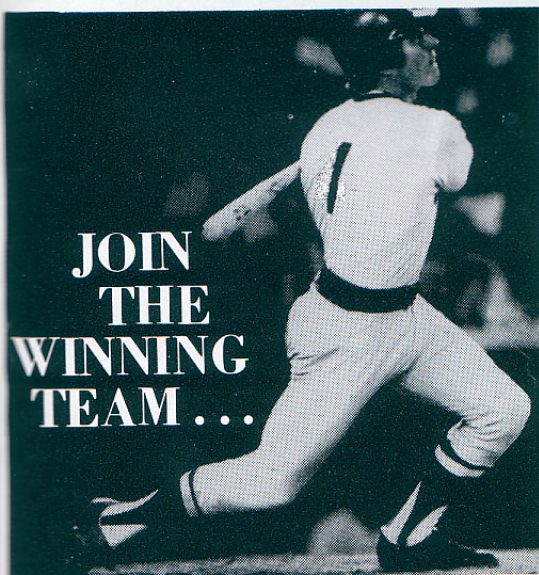
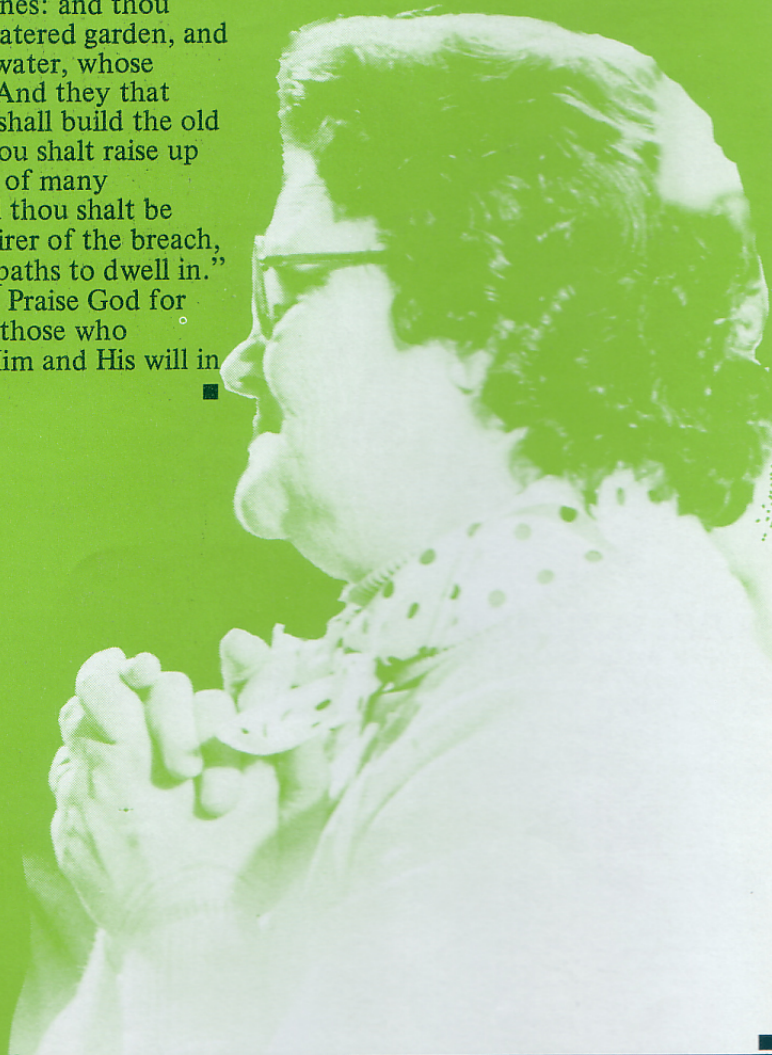

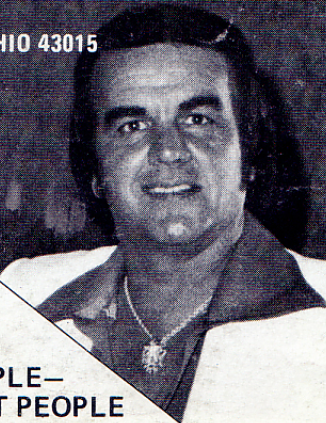
