

"Lest Ye Be Born Again"

Why do we need Salvation?

Sin is sin. Some may give it a fancy name: social disorder, crimes against nature, temporary insanity, revolution, etc. But it all boils down to one thing — sin is the result of three great temptations: lust of the eyes, lust of the flesh, and pride of life.

Because of lust and pride, man won't admit he needs God. No man likes to admit that he is a sinner. Instead, he spends billions of dollars searching and sweating for solutions to the problem of sin.

He sits around conference tables arguing and debating. He weakens and strengthens criminal codes. He stages revolutions. He uses psychiatry and drugs. Man has developed a thousand excuses for his behavior. He has created a thousand philosophies as to how the problem of sin can be solved. He has done everything but turn to God. You don't have to be a historian to see this hasn't worked.

Why do you think the crime rate is up? Why do you think the government is filled with corruption and deceit? Parents fear their children. People can't walk the streets at night. Why? Because we have turned our backs on God.

"Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ" (Col2:8).

All these traditions of men and rudiments of the world deal with changing mankind from the outside, through force or enticement. No type of government, no theology, no penal code has the power to change the basic sinful nature of man. You won't get to Heaven with your church membership card. If you're unhappy, all the college degrees, money, or drugs you might have won't help you.

The change must come from within: from the heart. You don't have the power to do it. You must have God's power. You must have Jesus Christ.

Salvation is the key to freedom. People who seek it are freed from guilt and self-hatred. They've stopped judging everyone else and have looked at their own hearts. They have been cleansed.

They will grow and prosper as they read the Word of God and apply it to their lives.

If you're sick and tired of the life you're living, you can have salvation. People try to make things so complicated, but salvation is beautifully simple.

Ask God to forgive you and welcome Jesus into your heart. God, through His divine mercy, will grant salvation (Ti 2:11). You will experience a revolution you never dreamed possible.

What is Sin?

Sin was the first act of free will that corrupted man. It is rebellion against the Lord (Deut 9:7). It is the transgression of the laws of God (I John 3:4). All unrighteousness is sin (I John 5:17). Whatever is not of faith is sin (Rom 14:23).

Probably the simplest description of sin is "to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin" (James 4:17). You don't fool anyone. You know right from wrong. If you're not doing what is right, you are sinning.

Sin originates with Satan. "Ye are of your father, the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do" (John 8:44). Sin comes from the heart. "Out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies" (Mt 15:19).

You won't hear too many people talking about sin. It makes them feel uncomfortable. This discomfort is their own conviction — their feeling of guilt.

How do we Sin?

We sin with our moral character: "Whosoever looketh on a woman with lust hath committed adultery with her in his heart" (Mt 5:28). And we sin with our actions: "What doth it profit, though a man say he hath faith, and have not works?" (James 2:14).

You can and will make mistakes. But you don't sin by mistake. A mistake is not a sin. Your conscience, which is God-given, allows you to know right from wrong. When you commit a sin, it is a conscious effort; a deliberate choice between good and evil.

People ask, "Why can't I just be a good person? Why do I need God?" Without the guidelines set forth in the Bible, "good" would become a relative term. Your "good" would differ from my "good". The Bible says that none is good — that all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God (Rom 5:12).

Some may wonder why God would allow sin to exist. People blame everything on God. God doesn't send anyone to hell. People send themselves to hell. God is not responsible for sin.

First, God gave man free will so that he could worship Him by choice — which is a much greater tribute than worshipping Him by force.

Second, God's infinite justice is made manifest in His punishment of sin.

Third, God's infinite grace is

made manifest in His forgiveness of sin.

The Result of Sin

"The wages of sin is death" (Rom 6:23). The sinner who does not accept the blood of Christ as his salvation will suffer eternal separation from God. People require and respect a blood sacrifice. Do you think God enjoyed watching His own Son beaten, spat upon, humiliated, and killed? The Bible says that at the moment of Jesus' death, God had to turn His head. Jesus had to die to show us that He meant business. He knew His death would strike home with us. He loves you. He laid down His life for us. Why can't we accept that?

Temptation

All men are tempted, but may choose not to sin. Jesus suffered great temptation for *forty days*, yet He was without sin. The devil tempted Him when He was weak and hungry. The devil will attack you at your weak moments.

"Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God; for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man. But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed. Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin; and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death." (James 1:13-15)

The devil uses three devices to tempt man: the lust of the flesh, lust of the eyes, and the pride of life.

Ironically, the thing that's really tempting you may appear to be great and wonderful. But after you have allowed your temptation to become sin, you'll find it's not so great after all and wasn't worth making God angry over. Sin is just a temporary pleasure . . . and it is followed by shame.

Although temptation is a strong force, almost irresistible at times, "God is faithful, who will not permit you to be tempted above that ye are able, but will, with the temptation, also make the way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it" (I

Cor 10:13).

"The devil made me do it" is no excuse. "The Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations" (2 Peter 2:9).

Many people want to

know how they can discern God's voice from the devil's. God is positive. The devil is negative. God instructs you to do something and the devil will try to hinder you. God will speak to you and tell you to do something. The devil will follow right after and say "Well . . . now . . . I don't know if you should do that." The devil is wishywashy, argumentative, and uses a lot of "buts" and "what-ifs". There are no ifs, ands or buts with God. He may speak to you directly. He speaks to you through His Word or other people. God won't nag you but the devil will. Sometimes God speaks to me audibly. Sometimes through visions. When God

speaks to you, you will know it.

You must always wear the armor of God (Eph 6:14-18).



I am the resurrection and the life...

The Son of God knew He was to be crucified. His Father had told Him. Jesus had taught and had warned His disciples that these things must be.

Jesus had told the Jews, "If you destroy this temple, in three days I will raise it up again." (John 2:19) Having their understanding darkened and evil within their hearts, they knew only to pass this among themselves as a by-word to laugh about. Later, at Jesus' trial (Mark 14:58) and crucifixion (Mark 15:29), they mocked the Lord with His own words of truth, daring Him to come down from the cross.

Little did they know that God had better things for His Son — and for us.

FOR THIS CAUSE CAME I UNTO THIS HOUR

At a feast in Bethany the Lord had spoken boldly and earnestly before the people, speaking more to His Father than to those around Him; explaining that — like a corn of wheat, which must die in the ground in order to bear much fruit — He must die in order to bring forth that great miracle of a life eternal. (John 12:24)

He admitted, "Now is my soul troubled; but what shall I say? Father, save me from this hour: but for this cause came I unto this hour." (John 12:27)

Have you any idea how much love that statement took! Jesus knew that, as David had said, His hands and feet would be pierced. (Psalm 22:15 & 16) He knew that Isaiah had spoken truly when he said, "He was tormented for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities; ... He was taken from prison and from judgment ... and cut off from the land of the living." (Isaiah 53:5, 7, 8) He knew that soon Zechariah 9:9 would be fulfilled as He would ride into Jerusalem on the foal of an ass, bringing salvation.

How greatly His Father loved Him because He was willing to be obedient — even to pouring His soul out unto death. It was HIS choice — a choice of love — because His Father loved Him.

He said to the Pharisees: "Therefore doth my Father love me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again. NO MAN TAKETH IT FROM ME, BUT I LAY IT DOWN OF MYSELF. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again." (John 10:17 & 18) At His humiliating trial, Jesus told the elders, the chief priests, and the scribes, "Hereafter shall the Son of man sit on the right hand of the power of God."

The Son was going home again!!

HE THAT WAS DEAD CAME FORTH

Jesus' home-going would be far different from that of His beloved friend, Lazarus, however.

Mary and Martha had sent word to Jesus that Lazarus was sick. When Jesus arrived, He was greeted with, "If you had only been here, Lazarus would still live! But I know that even now whatsoever thou wilt ask of God, God will give it thee." (John 11:3, 20-22) Jesus assured

Martha that her brother would rise again — not only at that last day, as she supposed, but that very day!

The words the Lord spoke to Martha that day flow through our own souls with the thrill of expectation! "I am the resurrection and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live."

When He called into the cave which held the dead body, "Lazarus, COME FORTH!" Lazarus had to obey the command. He that was dead came forth!

Jesus knew that He would soon be obeying that same command — that He would soon be laying aside graveclothes to walk again with the living.

However, Lazarus would one day face death again. The Son of God was resurrected into life eternal!

The Son was going home again to the glory which He had before the world was! (John 17:5) He had been obedient: He had not only *told* of the name of His Father; but He had also MANIFESTED the name of God to all men.

The Son was going home again to intercede in prayer for His own. But not just yet. First, there were more things to be manifested in the name of the Father!

WHY SEEK YE THE LIVING AMONG THE DEAD?

The women who had taken the anointing spices to the tomb of Christ's burial were perplexed by the gently reprimanding question of the angel: "Why seek ye the living among the dead? Don't you remember what you were taught?" (Luke 24:5 & 6)

The time had come for the living, resurrected Christ to fellowship with His followers. He was concerned about the grief and the shock they felt after His crucifixion. Imagine the thrill they felt when they realized they had walked on an Emmaus road with the resurrected Christ!

Being a person of such great love, the Lord was concerned once more about His fisherman friends and gave them instructions to make a great catch when they had failed by their own efforts. (John 21:4-13)

As He had calmed their fears in the storm, He once more calmed their fears where they were hiding behind locked doors, wondering if they were to be crucified next. (John 20:19)

And He ate with them. "I'm not a spirit," said He, "spirits don't have flesh and bones!" (Luke 24: 36-43)

He reminded them of the prophecies in the law of Moses, in the prophets and in the Psalms. With the same words that He used to put the devil in his place, He said, "It is written . . ." It had to come to pass, because it had been written by the inspiration of God, His Father: "Thus it is written, and thus it

behoved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day." It had been written and it had been done. (Luke 24:46)

In Capernaum Jesus repeated three times: "Those who see the Son and believe will have everlasting life and I will raise him up that last day!" (John 6:39, 40, 44)

Have your loins girded about with truth. "Set your affection on things above, not on things on earth" (Col 3:2).

Wear the breastplate of righteousness. "Abhor that which is evil; cling to that which is good" (Rom 12:9). "Resist the devil and he will flee from you" (James 4:7).

Shod your feet with the gospel of peace. Carry "the shield of faith, with which ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked." (Eph 6:16) Don't ever fear. The devil is not equal to God. He is a fallen angel, subordinate to God and can only go as far as God allows. If your faith is in God, you can't lose.

"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (I John 1:9). With the helmet of salvation we will be victorious.

Bear the sword of the Spirit. "If ye through the Spirit, do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live" (Rom 8:13).

Know the scriptures. When the devil tempted Jesus, he perverted the scriptures. But Jesus knew the scriptures just as well, and used them as His defense.

Overcome the devil with the blood of the Lamb and by the word of your testimony (Rev 12:11).

Love is the key. If you love God, and obey His commandments, and if you love your neighbor as yourself, you should have no problem overcoming temptation.

Rejoice, pray without ceasing, and praise God, for "the god of peace shall bruise satan under your feet shortly" (Rom 16:20)

You will be happy. "We count them happy who endure" (James 5:11). You will have the joy of victory and a closer relationship with God.

Your character will improve; having acquired new patience and understanding.

You will be stronger and yet greatly humbled knowing that you were victorious through the grace of God.

Those around you will be strengthened and will follow your example.

God has promised that those who are obedient "shall spend their days in prosperity and their years in pleasures" (Job 36:11).

Job was a wealthy and happy man. Because of it, he praised God continually. But the devil told God that if Job were poor and lost everything, he would no longer praise Him.

So God allowed the devil to take Job's family and wealth from him, to test his faith. Job could easily have turned on God and cursed God. I am sure he was tempted to. But instead, he continued to praise and trust God, through all the confusion.

Because of Job's faith, God restored all that he had previously possessed — and more!


