

It came to me that the lights represented the light of Christ that had been spread to people. This inspired me to preach on this topic, It was very effective. Many people were saved and filled with the Holy Ghost. I am giving the message of that service to you as an act of faith.

GOD'S COMMISSION

God sent His Son into the world to preach the Gospel, heal the sick, mend the brokenhearted, and set the captive free (Luke 4:18). Jesus said, "He that believeth on me, believeth not on me, but on him that sent me. And he that seeth me seeth him that sent me. I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness." (John 12:44-46) Jesus, in turn, told His disciples, "Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature." (Mark 16:15) Ever since, the Word of God has been preached, and soon the light of Christ began to shine in Chicago, Detroit, New York, and over the United States and around the world. People began to hear the good tidings of the Lord Jesus Christ and what He was doing to free people from their sins.

As the light of Christ began to burn into the world, it burned into the Catholic church, and nuns and priests began to receive the infilling of the Holy Ghost. Soon Baptists, Methodists, Lutherans, Jews -- people of all denominations -- began having

People began telling the story that Jesus is soon to come back again. "For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be." (Matt 24:27) When you hear the Gospel being preached through radio and television, you may know that the end is near. "And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come." (Matt. 24:14)

We are having more people saved than lost. There are people coming to Christ every day, and the number is getting greater. Out of that number that God has chosen (Matt 22:14), He said there are going to be 144,000 people that would carry His Name in their forehead -- chosen people of God! These people are going to be anointed of the Holy Spirit, dependable, and they are going to do whatever God tells them to do, whenever He tells them to do it.

Yes, one of these days, one of these mornings, one of these nights, people are going to be shaken, and they're going to think it's an earthquake. But this earthquake will reach throughout the world, and you will hear a loud sound of a trumpet like you have never heard before. (Matt 24:31) It is going to sound out, and the dead in Christ shall rise first. (I Thess 4:16) Graves will open, and the sea will give up its dead. (Rev. 20:13) And the Bible says whosoever is not found written in the Book of Life will be cast into the lake of fire. (Rev 20:15)

WHERE DO YOU STAND?

Think of your life as a candle, slowly burning to the end. Some of you don't realize how near your life is over. For some of you, your candle is burning bright, just as bright as when your life began. And it won't go out until it gets to the part that burns and hurts the most. And you will be able to feel the sting of death like you can feel the sting of fire when you get too close.

I'd like to ask you, have you examined yourself to see where you stand with God? Think for a moment. If you knew your candle would go out today, if you knew you were going to die, is there something in your life you would change, is there an apology that you would make? Is there something you know

you have done wrong and need to correct? You can't do that after death, my friend. It is appointed unto man once to die, but after this, the judgment. (Heb 9:27) You cannot repent after death; you cannot be forgiven after death. Today is the day of salvation. (II Cor 6:2)

If this was the end of your life, you would be shaken with fear. If you knew you were going to die, it would worry you. Why, you wouldn't mind writing the largest check you've ever written. You wouldn't mind sitting next to a black or a white person -- you wouldn't think you were better than each other. If someone could save your life, it wouldn't matter who reached out to help you, as long as they did. If you knew you were going to die, nothing would matter.

ONLY ONE LIFE

There are still a few dark corners in the world. The Gospel has not been preached to all the world, but one day it will be. You may be wondering when Christ will return. The Bible says not even the angels in heaven know. (Matt 24:36,42) So the Bible says, be ye also ready, be prepared. If you are called on to do something, be ready to do it.

Only one life will soon be past, and only what you have done for Christ will last. What have you done for God? Have you

sacrificed anything to do something good for someone else? Have you thought of your neighbor as yourself. Whatever you do, you must do it now while you are yet able, while you are still alive. This is your preparation ground. "Do all things without murmurings and disputings, that ye may be blameless and harmless, the Sons of God, without rebuke in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world." (Phil 2:14 & 15) The Bible tells us to work out our own plan of salvation (Phil 2:12) and it tells us to work for the night is coming when no man can work (John 9:4). I believe that!

"Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven." (Matt 5:14-16)

Ladies and gentlemen, somewhere there are people dying this moment. But that's not you. You can live on, if you get your faith right. God can tell you where your pitfalls are. He can tell you of that affliction that is working on your body to take your life. He will not only tell you, but He can do something about it. But you've got to be dedicated. 



CRUSADE

CHICAGO, ILLINOIS



In 1973, the first Chicago Crusade was held in the auditorium of Lane Technical School. The 2500-3000 people were so instantly warm and responsive to the works of the Lord there. It was as if the Lord handed Rev. Jenkins a church body there -- a far greater gift than any church building, no matter how grand and beautiful that building might be.

Two factors, God's goodness and the response of the people, multiplied the crowds so that the crusades were scheduled at the Auditorium Theatre for several meetings. It was necessary then, to move the crusades into one of the largest meeting places in Chicago: Arie Crown Theatre at McCormick Place. At each crusade it seemed that over half the people were there for their first time. In each crusade more than half the people stood for salvation because their hearts and their souls were so touched by the presence of the Lord and by His works of healing and deliverance.

When people can see for themselves the greatness and the goodness of God and the benefits He has for His children, they can't resist giving their hearts to Him and accepting the Son of God into their hearts and lives. This is the reason that people are so inspired to help Rev. Jenkins' ministry, that others might be blessed, too.

After so many people were introduced to this ministry, there came a day when it seemed that everyone in Chicago who had ever attended a crusade decided to come at the same time. On January 11th the auditorium was completely filled, with hundreds standing, and several thousands were locked out, standing in the lobby. The power of God fell on those in the lobby, as well as those in the Theatre. Many were healed and saved right there, as they praised the Lord.

At the last crusade in Chicago on March 21st, an over-flow room was provided so that more people could be seated and could at least hear the service. That was filled, and again, several hundreds were turned away. The faith and expectancy, the love and unity, the need and desire of the people was so great that the Lord granted Rev. Jenkins a greater anointing to do His work! The gift of knowledge that God gave him was expanded and deepened so that Rev. Jenkins was able to call many by name and to tell them in great detail about their problems and their sicknesses and about those at home who were in need, too.

The Lord set so many people free and took them into His kingdom! As Leroy Jenkins prayed for a deaf mute, he began to hear -- and to speak! A woman who had a deteriorated hip began walking and running after the Lord healed her!! The platform was filled with young people who had come forward to be delivered from drugs. For some it took a great deal of courage to chance being arrested for publicly admitting they used heroin. A ten-year-old and two twelve-year-olds were among that number! They had been on drugs for two years!

The Lord always moves in fantastic ways at each crusade in the city of Chicago.

CANTON, OHIO



At his home church in Delaware during the morning service, February 15th, Rev. Jenkins told his congregation two things that the Lord showed him about the service to be held in Canton that afternoon. There was to be a frail woman there who was dying of cancer. She was there! Since the Lord healed her that day, she has been to church in Delaware and has gained weight and strength.

Rev. Jenkins also told his Delaware congregation that 5,000 people would stand for salvation at Canton. It was a beautiful sight to see them all when they stood. And it was a beautiful sight to see 22 drug addicts join hands in a circle at the front of the huge auditorium of people and pray for each other for continued deliverance after Rev. Jenkins had laid his hands on them and had prayed for their release.

REPORTS

Rev. Jenkins was able to wipe a cancer from a woman's nose after the Lord drained it and healed it from the inside out. She sat looking at it in a handkerchief in awe and amazement.

Then the Lord led him to the back of the auditorium to a little boy who had cancer and tumors on his head. The Lord gave Rev. Jenkins a very special anointing to pray for that little boy in tongues and to prophecy a great blessing over him. Since that day, his hair, his eyelashes and eyebrows have grown back, and he has had to have a hair cut!

The Canton Crusade had been planned for 6,000. At the last minute an extra 4,000 chairs were set on the floor. Again hundreds stood at the back of the Canton Memorial Auditorium and many more hundreds were turned away at the door. At this first crusade in Canton, God has begun a marvelous work.

CHARLOTTE, NC



As Rev. Jenkins approached the Ovens Auditorium, February 27th, for his crusade there, he wondered impatiently about the cause of the terrible traffic jam in the area that slowed him down. He was amazed when he found that they had all come to see him!


Statistics show that people in great numbers are leaving churches where there is no concern for their souls, where salvation is not preached and where the power of God is not demonstrated to them. These people either give up church altogether, or they go out searching for the reality of a living God.

Thank God that people can find such reality in the ministry of Leroy Jenkins. People had travelled to Charlotte by faith for hundreds of miles and had waited for hours to hear this man of God. People by the thousands sat on the grass outside the auditorium in anticipation and hope, and in disappointment that they had not arrived in time to get a seat inside. Even Rev. Jenkins' aunt and uncle were not able to get in the auditorium!

Rev. Jenkins was so touched by the eager response of the people in his home area that he arranged for loud speakers to be installed for those outside that their hope and anticipation might not be in vain. Those people with a soul-hungry search were over-joyed to stand for salvation after they had witnessed and experienced the presence and the power of the living God!

After Rev. Jenkins arrived home, he found that many of the people had been mistreated by some of the firemen who were over-zealous in trying to control the crowds. Rev. Jenkins wants to extend his personal apology for their behavior. For this reason and because of the over-whelming crowd, the next crusade scheduled for Charlotte on May 30th will be held in the Coliseum next door. Many more thousands will be seated inside to witness the greatest ministry of our day.

DETROIT, MICHIGAN



And so it has been in each crusade. The Lord is drawing more and more people to hear the end-time message He has given Leroy Jenkins to deliver. Jesus is returning -- SOONER THAN WE WOULD DARE BELIEVE. He is so eager to have people believe, and to know Him and to accept Him! In each city the Lord has sent people to the crusades who do believe, people who are faithful helpers. There are such faithful helpers in Detroit, too.

The Detroit Crusades were first held at Cobo Hall, then at Ford Auditorium, as the attendance grew. And again, thousands had to be turned away because the seats were all taken.

The Lord again delivered many drug addicts there on February 1st, as He had been doing in several crusades. Some had to be coaxed from the balcony, through the gift of the word of knowledge concerning their situations.



We went to the Movieland Wax Museum in Buena Park, California, and the wind was blowing when we arrived. The stage was outside and made it even worse on Mae West, blowing her long blond hair around. She didn't seem to mind. She went right on with her speech.

Rock Hudson introduced her and they gave her a nice round of applause, as always. He talked awhile and people seemed to enjoy him as welf. Afterwards, the manager showed us all around the museum. We enjoyed it very much.

Then later, we went to a nice restaurant for dinner. Rock Hudson sat next to me and Mae West was at the head of the table. We began to discuss my occupation and he asked me if I was an actor or an entertainer of some sort. When I told him that I was a minister, he said, "You certainly don't look like one to me." I asked him, "What do ministers look like?" He said he always thought of a minister with a black coat and a turn around collar. I told him, "No, the Bible says that God looks on the heart but man looks on the outward appearance."

He sat for four hours and drank one cocktail after the other. He asked Miss West if she believed in my ministry...had she ever seen a miracle...and she said she had many times! She proceeded to tell him of a lady in one of the crusades that was in a coma...and after I prayed for her, the woman opened her eyes and talked. He said, "I would have to see it to believe it, because I have never seen a miracle before."



After four hours of talking about God most of all, I dismissed myself and told everyone that I would have to leave. Rock Hudson said, "There is a piano over there. Why don't you sing a song?" There were quite a few people in the place and I was a little embarrassed. I felt honored that he wanted me to sing a song, so I did.

There is just something about people that you watch on television or see at the movies that makes them sort of interesting to see them in person. I found him to be very outspoken, down to business and to the point. So you cannot ask for anyone to be any more honest than Rock Hudson was. Well, to sum it all up, he was a pretty nice person but not my cup of tea!

16 YEARS!

The early years of Leroy Jenkin's life was filled with heart break, anxiety, and a lot of tears. He knows what it means to be hungry and ragged. But during those hard times as a young child, God was speaking to Rev. Jenkins and giving him the comfort and guidance he needed.

The first time God spoke to him was when he was only five years of age. His mother had just had a nervous breakdown and was down to 90 pounds because of the lack of proper food, etc. As Leroy watched them take his mother from the house to the hospital, the Voice of the Lord said to Leroy, "You don't have to worry. 
Nine days of pain and suffering went by. He was released from the hospital, signing his own release, going home to die. Doctors only gave him three days to live, because gangrene had already set in.

A friend took Leroy Jenkins to a healing crusade where God miraculously touched and healed his arm, restoring it with new life...saved him and filled him with the Holy Spirit...all in one night's service.

Since that day, sixteen years ago, Leroy Jenkins has been listening to the Voice of the Lord and carrying this wonderful Gospel Story of Jesus Christ and His miracle power to millions around the world.








SUMMARY
