

A supernatural vision given A. A. Allen in Atlanta

Brother Allen suddenly stopped the praise service and moved to the front of the platform, with that holy awe about him that we long ago learned was the presence of God which surrounds him when the Lord is giving him a vision.

"Listen! God is showing me a vision!" he began.

"I see people - hundreds of people. Yes! It is you, the audience right here under this tent! It is not somewhere else, nor anyone else! It is you! But you are not standing back there by your seats, where the chairs are in rows. I see you standing across the front.

"It is tonight, for I see the puddle of water over there, that has formed because of the rain running down the tent poles because the covers have not yet been placed over the poles.

"I see hundreds of you standing in two long rows. There is someone from the far end coming down between the rows.

"Now I see Him better! It is Jesus coming! He is walking down between the rows. And I see people with fingers missing, and as Jesus passes by they become perfect, fingers growing out from the stubs!

"I see a man standing here with a stub at his elbow! His arm is off! That man is somewhere under this tent tonight! As Jesus passes by, he touches him, and on that stub, instantly, there is an arm with five beautiful fingers on it!

"Wait! I see Jesus as He raises up! He is looking toward me! "I thought it was Jesus, but it is not Jesus! It is a man!
"If I don't tell you this, it seems I will die. Don't think me

exalted or puffed up. I have to say it! Because I believe tonight that God is going to use an evangelist to perform the miraculous. Do you believe it?

"I see people falling prostrate. I see and hear the people shouting, rejoicing, declaring that GOD has performed the miraculous for them at last!"

"Now that man is Jesus again! And now I know what this means! This is what Paul meant when he said, 'I will walk in them!' (2 Cor. 6:16.) He means that He will walk in His preachers, pastors, evangelists, teachers! He will move in us, and work in us. God will work through us, and will perform the miraculous through us, if we yield to Him and believe Him

tonight!
"JESUS IS HERE! He is in US!"

As the congregation at that time was invited to come forward to receive miracles, many shouted and rejoiced over miraculous healings which occurred there before their eyes. But the MOST MARVELOUS FULFILLMENT of this vision came eleven days later, on a Wednesday night, as an arm was restored WHICH HAD BEEN CUT OFF! The story is told and pictured on these pages. THE STORY OF LEROY JENKINS!

"Oh God! I've cut off my arm!"

LeRoy Jenkins turned and ran across the street to a neighbor, who tied a tourniquet around the arm to stop the gushing blood and hurried him to the hospital.

A sheet of plate glass had burst and fallen, severing LeRoy's right arm above the elbow, slicing through bone and muscle, cutting nerves, tendons, veins, and arteries, and leaving only about an inch of skin holding the arm dangling from the stump.

As he ran across the street, blood gushed from the large arteries that had been severed, soaking his clothing and running down and filling his shoes. By the time he reached the hospital, his body was almost drained of its life blood. The doctors began pumping blood into his body immediately.

"When I got to the hospital," LeRoy declares, "I felt myself dying. I was cold all over, and my body and mouth began trembling. I knew I was dying, and I knew I wasn't ready to die. I had failed God, and I didn't feel I even had

any right to call on Him!"

He explained, "God had called me to preach when I was just a little boy. I have fought it all my life. I have even wanted to kill myself to get out of having to preach. I am sorry now. God has saved me, and I am ready to do His will!"

LeRoy's mother declared she knew God would not let him diel She knew God's call and God's purpose for his life, and believed steadfastly that God would spare him and use him.

"The doctor told me he didn't know what to think about it," LeRoy continued. "He said he had seen people die who were not in as bad shape as I was. I didn't have any blood left!"

The doctors declared it would be impossible to save the arm, it was too nearly completely severed. But when LeRoy and his brother, who was with him, begged that an attempt be made to save it, they sewed the arm back

in place, declaring that within a few days they would have to cut it off again.

"I don't doubt God," the doctor said, "I know He can do anything. I will have to turn it over to Him, for I have done all I can do!"

IN NEED OF A MIRACLE

A few days later, as Brother Allen was leaving for the afternoon service, he met LeRoy in the parking lot. His arm was in a cast, and tears streamed down his face. "I never saw a man weep so," Brother Allen declared. "The pain was so great, and he was taking so much dope to deaden the pain that he felt that all together it was driving him crazy! I asked him if he believed God could perform a miracle. He said, 'Yes, sir, I dol'

"I told him to come back the next evening and get a miracle card. I told him God was going to put new life

into that dead arm!"

But God didn't wait that long! That night, LeRoy came back to the service. As Brother Allen preached, using as his text, "We Have Seen Strange Things Today," God began to speak to his heart about LeRoy Jenkins. He stopped and told the congregation, "There is a young man here for whom I believe in my heart God is going to do something tremendous! Of course he will have to believe with me. I don't believe God wants this young man to go through life with only one arm. I believe that tonight God is going to perform a miracle for him."

As LeRoy came forward, Brother Allen described the accident to the congregation. He explained that although the severed arm had been sewed back in place, he had no control of the fingers, since all tendons had been severed. There was no feeling in the arm or hand, as the nerves were cut. There was no circulation, for the arteries and veins had been cut, and to prevent the young man from bleeding to death, the blood vessels had been tied off.

"What do you believe God is going to do, Son?" Brother

Allen asked.

"You want to keep that arm, and be able to use it normally, just as you did before?"

"Yes, sir!"

Then LeRoy explained the accident. He told how God had called him, and how he had rebelled against God's call, how he had cried out to God when death was upon him, and had been saved.

"You say the doctors declare that arm will never work

again?"

LeRoy confirmed this and declared, "God is going to

restore my arm tonight!"

Suddenly Brother Allen exclaimed, "Oh! He's using his fingers! Look! He is opening and closing his hand! He is shutting his fist! Look! It's already done!"

Joyfully, LeRoy raised his hands and shouted praises to God! Those who were nearby saw the dead, blackness drain from his fingers, and a healthy glow return to the hand

Excitement ran high!

Thousands rose to their feet and surged forward to get a closer view, to watch a young man moving his fingers, raising and lowering an arm, now fully alive; an arm which a few moments before had been dead and helpless!



When LeRoy returned to the doctor the following day to show him what God had done, the doctor declared, "But it is impossible! That arm was more than cut off! I spent five hours tying off every blood vessel in that arm so that there could not possibly be any circulation of blood through that arm!"

STRETCHED FORTH!

"Last night I preached at a Baptist church before coming to the services at the tent, where I arrived late," LeRoy Jenkins testified. "As I told them the wonderful story of how God has restored my arm, a number of those Baptists, including the pastor, concluded that such an arm could properly be called God's arm, or an Arm of the Lord! They believed that if I would just touch them with my hand, they would be healed. I agreed with them. And as I began to pray for those who came forward, laying my hand upon them, GOD HEALED EVERYONE!"

Then he went on to tell a story which was a near tragedy. "This afternoon when I got home," he declared, my little boy had been involved in an accident while riding his bicycle. His head had been cut open, his mouth cut, and two huge ruptures had appeared on his stomach, one on each side! You could see his intestines protruding under the skin!
