Thousands of people sitting in churches throughout the world do not hear the truth.

They are told they can't rejoice aloud, that God does not work miracles. Some are taught against the deity of Christ by denying that He was born of a virgin. They think they must dress and behave in a certain way. I once knew a lady who wouldn't cut her hair...but she dipped snuff!

This is man's way. This is a doctrine created of man and not based solely and completely upon the Bible.

The Lord doesn't want a lot of different denominations and doctrines. He said He was coming after A glorious church - not a bunch of glorious churches. (Eph 5:27) Is there going to be a Pentecostal Heaven? A Protestant Heaven? A Catholic Heaven? Of course not! We'd better start trying to get along with each other now because we're going to have to spend eternity together.

"Woe be unto the pastors that destroy and scatter the sheep of my pasture! saith the Lord." (Jer 23:1) There is one Lord, one faith, and one baptism." (Eph 4:5) "Now I beseech you, brethren...that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you, but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment." (I Cor 1:10)

If your church is dead..if you are not being fed spiritually..get out! And don't let some dried-up congregation turn you off to God.

The Christian should wake up and make a joyful noise. He should be active and speak out boldly. He can laugh and have fun and still be sincere. Some of you endure your religion instead of enjoying it.

Many have a form of Christianity but lack power. They're afraid to praise God because of what their next door neighbor thinks.

Remember, someone who's miserable wants you to be miserable, too. If you're a Christian, they'll try to get you dressed in rags. They'll make a doormat out of you. But when you get saved, you ought to show it. Clean up, dress up, and have some fun with your religion. There are plenty of professing Christians who won't wear lipstick, but they are the first to run out back of the church wagging their long tongues.

Get your minds off judging other people and clean up your own back yard. Man looks on the outward appearance but God looks at the heart.(I Sam 6:7)

Preachers are supposed to inspire you. They are supposed to lead the people—not be led. Some have no business preaching. If they would stop taking orders from headquarters and get anointed, they could make an impact. Instead, they are afraid. They fear losing members or they fear censure from other clergy. Thank God I was born standing up and talking back!

Some people like to be sweet-talked by their preachers. But what folks need to hear is the truth. Preachers had better start getting some backbone. *Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all long-suffering and doctrine.*" (II Tim 4:2)

So called "liberal" preachers have taken the spiritual value out of the Bible and have given it social meaning. They say you can't interpret the Bible literally. Well, then, why read it all? They say the Bible was written in parables. But when Jesus spoke in parables He specifically said so. Why read the Bible at all if you're going to call it a lie?

Scientists and researchers spend billions of dollars trying to prove the Bible wrong. They were saying that God didn't destroy the earth with a great flood until they discovered Noah's Ark, perfectly preserved in an iceberg. It was the same ark, built according to Biblical specifications and found in the exact spot the Bible said it would be. They said that the Red Sea was so shallow that God didn't even need to part it. But it was deep enough to drown the Egyptian soldiers.

There will always be skeptics. They might as well give up. The more they try to prove the Bible wrong, the more they prove it right! If you would take the time to check it out, you'd see that all this astrology, evolution, and other antichrist philosophy is a bunch of nonsense.

We have a right to fight the devil. Look how quickly they took prayer out of the school because of just one woman. When something happens, people are too afraid or too lazy to do anything about it. When they wanted to take religious broadcasting off the air, did you write and complain to the FCC? Thank God that my members sent about 5,000 pieces of mail to the FCC in protest. And thank God that Madelyn Murray O'Hara has resigned and given up! Praise the Lord! That's what Christians can do when they stick together.

Some preachers have the nerve to rewrite the Bible. They take what they like and ignore the rest. They are more interested in pleasing Caesar than God. Both Moses (Deut 4:2) and John (Rev 22:18) said not to add to or detract from the Word of God. When you preach, it is a tremendous responsibility. You had better be sure you are doing it right. *"For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all."* (James 2:10)

We have got to quit compromising and get back to the Word of God. We've got to stop worrying about what man thinks and start worrying about what God thinks.

Instead, a bunch of theologians get together and set up seminaries where they can study and "interpret" the Bible. There is even a group that calls themselves the "higher criticism." They think they know more than God! *"Where is the wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the disputer of this world? Hath not God made foolish the wisdom of this world?"* (1 Cor 1:20)

"Neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly edifying which is in faith." (1 Tim 1:4) *"If any man preach any other gospel unto you than that you have received, let him be accursed."* (Gal 1:9) *"If any man teach otherwise, and consent not to wholesome words, even the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to the doctrine which is according to godliness; he is proud, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof cometh envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings."* (1 Tim 6:3,4)

If you have to argue religion, you haven't got it. Any man that sows discord among brethren is an abomination to the Lord. (Prov 6:16,19) Don't let your minds be corrupted from *"the simplicity that is in Christ."* (1 Cor 11:3)

Some people criticize me because I didn't go to Bible School. No, I was called by God. *"Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit."* (John 15:16) The ordination papers that man gives you won't do you a bit of good if you are not guided by the Holy Spirit. God can give you wisdom. The Bible says that the Holy Spirit will bring all things to your remembrance. A piece of paper can't give you power, but God can. It was all those sophisticated priests, those Sadducees and Pharisees who hindered Christ the most with all their rules and regulations. They were envious of His spiritual gifts.

You don't judge a man by what people say. You judge him by his spirit and by his fruits. I must be doing something right. I've got more people in the restrooms than a lot of preachers have in their entire congregations.

I'm not perfect. I make mistakes. But I'm not afraid to tell you if I do. I may not have an education but neither did most of the disciples. Yet they had great power with which to help many people. Why? Because they were obedient. They followed after charity and desired spiritual gifts. They preached the Gospel.

A Miracle until . .*



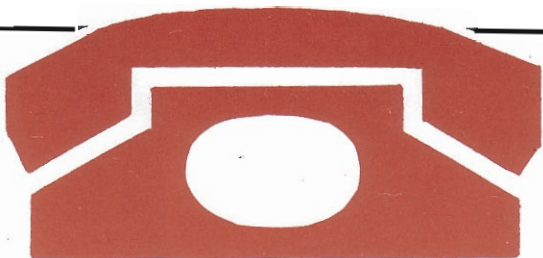

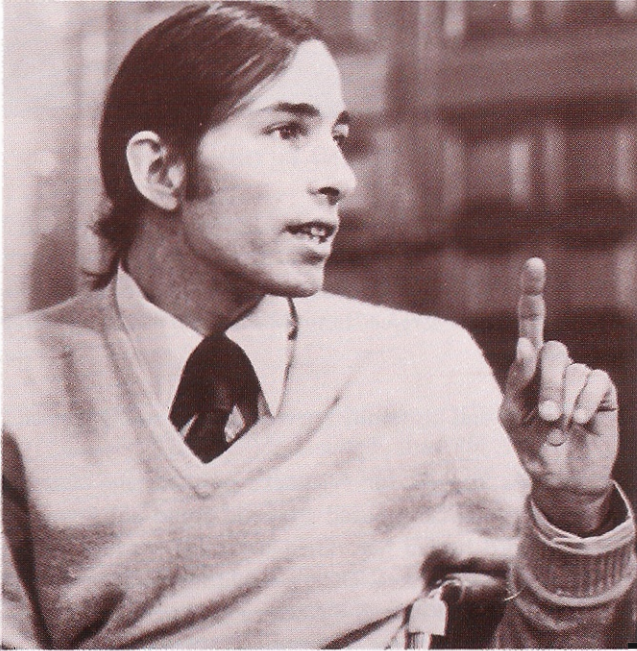
Doctor says, "It's a Miracle"

I met Rev. Leroy Jenkins three years ago through my father, John Derek, who had met him 13 years earlier while working on a motion picture. Our first encounter was in Long Beach, California, during one of his crusades. We did not have a great deal of time then to discuss the future . . . his or mine. But that did give us a brief opportunity to introduce ourselves, at which time he expressed an interest in having me work for him. Shortly following that meeting, I came into a large sum of money. The next few years went by without any further contact.



Three years later, money exhausted and comfortably employed in a job that was not at all rewarding, Rev. Jenkins telephoned my father, again inquiring about me, stating that he was still interested in having me come and work for him. It was not clear what I would do. My qualifications had not been discussed yet, but he was sure I was needed.

A few weeks later Rev. Jenkins returned to Los Angeles with his photographer, Rod Sherrell. I went to the hotel where they were staying. This was our first chance to seriously discuss in what capacity I could help his crusade for Christ.

It was only at this time that we were able to discuss my training, abilities, and potential. We began to talk about the ministry, what it meant, and some of its goals. At that point I told him of the experience that I had with suicide prevention, working in hospitals with crippled as well as exceptional children, the psychology which I studied while attending college, my interest in counseling, and involvement with the Pentecostal movement in California. Something I said obviously convinced Rev. Jenkins that he had just the job for me, because he once again invited me to join the church and his staff in their evangelical quest. There was really very little left to say except what, where, when.

It has now been approximately three weeks since my arrival at the Holy Hill Cathedral in Delaware, Ohio. Each day that has passed has been rich and fulfilling. The love exuded through my brethren and fellow staff has made my orientation extremely simple, and this explains the success of Rev. Jenkins' ministry as found in I Corinthians 13, which reads:

I may speak in tongues of men or of angels, but if I am without love, I am a sounding gong or a clanging cymbal. I may have the gift of prophecy, and know every hidden truth; I may have faith strong enough to move mountains; but if I have no love, I am nothing. I may dole out all I possess, or even give my body to be burnt, but if I have no love, I am none better.

Love is patient; love is kind and envies no one. Love is never boastful, nor conceited, nor rude; never selfish, not quick to take offense. Love keeps no score of wrongs, does not gloat over other men's sins, but delights in the truth. There is nothing love cannot face; there is no limit to its faith, its hope, and its endurance.

Love will never come to an end. Are there prophets? Their work will be over. Are there tongues of ecstasy? They will cease. Is there knowledge? It will vanish away; for our knowledge and our prophecy alike are partial, and the partial vanishes when wholeness comes. When I was a child, my speech, my outlook, and my thoughts were all childish. When I grew up, I had finished with childish things. Now we see only puzzling reflections in a mirror, but then we shall see face to face. My knowledge now is partial; then will it be whole, like God's knowledge of me. In a word, there are three things that last forever: faith, hope, and love; but the greatest of them all is love. (New English Version)

This, too, is Rev. Jenkins' philosophy, and is reflected in my daily relationship with his staff, my co-workers.

Rev. Jenkins has encouraged me to write a book about my life in Hollywood as the son of a famous movie star. He insists that it be an honest recounting of the positive and negative sides, of the effects that the celluloid capitol of the world can have on its inhabitants.

Lynette and Alyce, my wife and seven-year-old daughter, remained in Los Angeles because of my wife's art education. They will be visiting me this summer and most definitely will be joining me permanently shortly thereafter.

I look forward to getting acquainted with many of you in the upcoming year, and hopefully I will be a blessing to all, especially the handicapped. So, if you are in Delaware at the Holy Hill Cathedral, or in one of our future crusades, I am the quadruple leg in the wheelchair, with the long hair and the friendly smile.

DAYTON, OHIO

On the Johnny Walker Show (WKEF-TV) Rev. Jenkins had said that the entire Dayton Convention Center would be filled to overflowing at the second crusade held there. And it came to pass! On October 19th the seats were filled, hundreds stood at the back and hundreds stood outside.

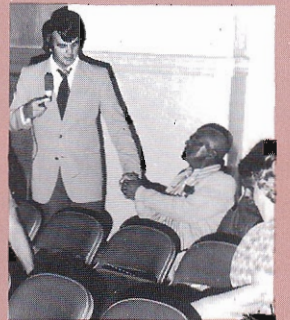

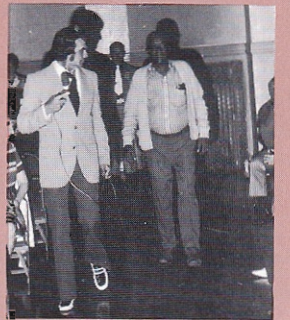

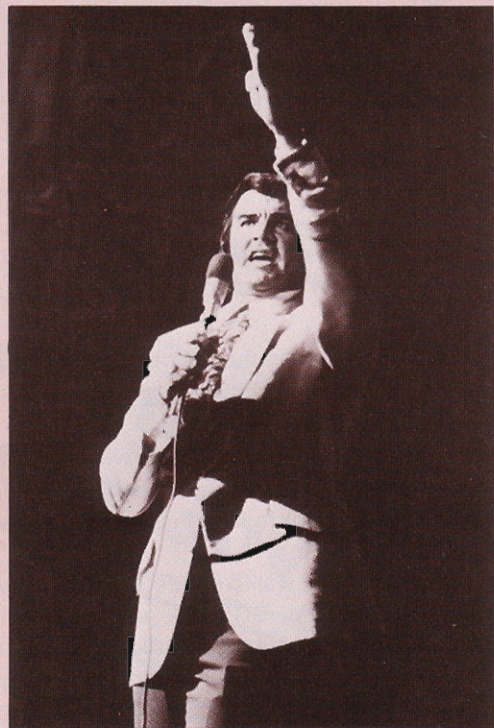

Short Sermon — GOSSIP

Almost everyone is familiar with the Ten Commandments. People think that as long as they don't break them, they're all right. But God has also given us, in the Bible, guidelines by which we are supposed to live. He said that if a man were to offend the law in one point, he would be offending in all points.

"These six things doth the Lord hate; yea, seven are an abomination unto Him. A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, a heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief, a false witness that speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren." (Proverbs 6:16-19)

One of the greatest problems within Christian institutions is gossip. *If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion is vain.*" (James 1:26) Gossip hurts and destroys. An unbridled tongue is of the devil. Gossip offends God, stirs up strife, and disrupts constructive Christian activity.

You know gossipers. You know the kind of people I'm talking about. In church they're speaking in tongues louder than anyone else. But after church, they're out back wagging those same tongues. Gossipers are hypocrites!

If you've been hurt by gossip, check it out. Go to the source. Consider the source. Don't build up resentment in your own heart. If the gossip continues, ignore it. Rejoice, because the Bible says you are blessed when man speaks evil against you falsely for the beliefs you hold. (Matthew 5:11 & 12)

They don't know they only hurt themselves. *"...whoever stirs up strife with you shall fall because of you."* (Isaiah 54:15) *"There is no peace, saith my God, to the wicked."* (Isaiah 57:21)

If **you** are a gossipier, you are really hurting yourself and giving a blessing to your victim. *"...Every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give an account thereof in the day of judgment."* (Matthew 12:36)

The Bible is true. *"Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away."* (Matt 24:35) There is no time limit on God's Word.
