God tells us in His Word that we should "study to show thy-self approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." (II Tim 2:15) But what exactly does God want us to study? He tells us that we should search the Scriptures. (John 5:39) "These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so." (Acts 17:11) From this Scripture, we see that God approves of study, and that we, as Christians, should read and study His Word daily. In so doing, we will be able to discern between right and wrong. We will know the truth (John 17:17), and the truth will set us free. (John 8:32)

THE PARABLE OF THE SOWER

Jesus spoke many things to the people in parables. He used the simple things of the world to confound the wise. "Therefore speak I to them in parables: because they seeing see not; and hearing they hear not, neither do they understand." (Matt 13:13) In the following parable, the seed is the Word of God.

"... Behold, a sower went forth to sow; And when he sowed, some seeds fell by the wayside, and the fowls came and devoured them up: (Matt 13:3,4) -- When you hear the Word of God and don't understand it, the devil will be right there to confuse you and take away what you heard. (Matt 13:19) Although you may be wise according to the world's standards, if you lack understanding, you are fighting a losing battle. That is why God says, "Get wisdom, get understanding: forget it not. Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding." (Prov 4:5,7) We need to have understanding of God's Word. "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding." (Prov 9:10)

There is power in knowing and understanding the Word of God. If we know God's Word, we will be able to identify the devil when he tries to come against us or trick us. We can use scripture to resist the devil. Jesus Christ did when Satan tempted Him in the wilderness. We can use God's Word as our weapon in the spiritual warfare in which we are engaged. "Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; and your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit,

which is the word of God." (Eph 6:13-17) "For the word of God is quick and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart." (Heb 4:12)

"Some fell upon stony places, where they had not much earth: and forthwith they sprung up, because they had no deepness of earth: And when the sun was up, they were scorched; and because they had no root, they withered away." (Matt 13:5,6)-Many people hear God's Word, and are eager to serve Him and do what is right. But when tribulation or persecutions arise because of the Word, they become defeated and give up simply because they lack understanding. Once you decide to serve God and take your stand for Him, you will be fought by the devil and his gang. People are supposed to talk about you. Why, you are no different than

Jesus Christ. They accused Him falsely of many things. They even called Him a whoremonger and a winebibber. But did He whine and complain and finally give up? No!! He kept right on going.

They hated Christ without a cause (John 15:25), and the same thing will happen to you. Whenever you are doing something for God, people will talk about you. Why do you think my ministry is fought so hard? It is because we are reaching millions of people with the saving and healing power of God, and the devil and his gang don't like it. The devil knows he doesn't have much time left before the return of Jesus Christ, and he is trying to destroy everyone and everything he can. That is why God says, "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour." (I Pet 5:8)

The trouble with people today is they give up too easy—they don't have any backbone. When the going gets rough, and it seems like more than you can bear, that is when you need to say, like Job, "Though he slay me, yet will I trust him."(Job 13:15) God never promised that being a Christian would be an easy life, but He said He would be with us and help us. "And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that endureth to the end shall be saved." (Matt 10:22)

"And some fell among the thorns; and the thorns sprung up, and choked them." (Matt 13:7) -- Jesus went on to explain this further. "He also that received seed among the thorns is he that heareth the word; and the care of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, choke the word, and he becometh unfruitful." (Matt 13:22) Some people want to serve God, and begin to bear fruit for the Lord, but somewhere down the road they are tricked by the devil and become concerned with the cares of this world. Christ tells us that we should not worry about what we will eat, drink, wear, or even do tomorrow. God knows we need certain things, and He will supply all our needs if we keep Him first in our life. (Matt 6:31-33) Praise the Lord!!

Many people today want to see how much money and material goods they can acquire. This becomes their main goal in life. They don't understand that it is only in giving that they can receive. In being so concerned about these worldly things, Christ is no longer the center of their life, and they become unfruitful and die spiritually. Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me. If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned." (John 15:2

4,6) "Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire." (Matt 7:19)

We are not supposed to put our trust in weapons (Ps 44:6), wealth (Ps 49:6,7), leaders (Ps 146:3), man (Jer 17:5), works (Jer 48:7), or our own righteousness (Ezek 33:13). Rather, we are to trust in God's Holy Name (Ps 33:31), His mercy (Ps 52:8), and His Word (Ps 119:42). And how can we trust God's Word if we don't study it and have understanding? By trusting in God, we can enjoy all His benefits. If we put our trust in God, He promises us joy (Ps 5:11), deliverance (Ps 22:4,5), triumph over our enemies (Ps 25:2,3), His goodness (Ps 31:19), mercy (Ps 32:10), provision (Ps 37:3,5), blessedness (Ps 40:4), safety (Ps 56:11), usefulness (Ps 73:28), guidance (Prov 3:5,6), and inheritance (Isa 57:13). Praise God!!!

"But other fell into the ground, and brought forth fruit, some an hundredfold, some sixtyfold, some thirtyfold." (Matt 13:8) -- This is referring to the person who hears and understands the Word of God. Because of this hearing and understanding, he is able to bear fruit for the Lord. God expects us to bear fruit. He tells us to be doers of the Word and not hearers only. (James 1:22) "Every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit. I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing. If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you." (John 15:2,5,7) Praise the Lord!!

"Who hath ears to hear, let him hear." (Matt 13:9) - God is speaking to the church today. He is trying to get the people ready for the things that are about to take place. Now is the time for us to draw close to God and learn of Him and His Spirit. We need to search the Scriptures daily and seek God, while He can still be found. We need to hide the Word of God in our hearts and minds. "Thy word have I hid in my heart, that I might not sin against thee." (Ps 119:11) The Word of God is food to the Christian. If we do not partake of this food, we will soon die spiritually. As we partake of the Word daily, we will grow in our understanding and knowledge of God. 





Soon many of you - or your children - will be brought under the discipline of learning at various types of schools. Students who have the person who wrote their text book as their teacher are fortunate, indeed.

For example, if a person wants to be a student in the skill of carpentry, a good text book is a great help. A good carpenter is an even greater asset for learning. But the greatest combination a student could ever hope for is to have a classroom filled with carpenter's tools, and classmates who are really interested in learning carpentry and interested in seeing beautiful works as the result of their efforts. He would need a good text book which lays out the pattern for learning and doing. He would need a "master teacher" -- a teacher who has come under the discipline of carpentry that he might know carpentry from beginning to end, one who knows how to have the patience and the understanding to get that skill across to others, a teacher who is the author of the text book! With a combination like that, a student who is eager and willing to learn can name his own goal!

And you know that people who have met the author of any well-known book feel very special. They are looked upon with a touch of awe by those who hear the proud comment, "I met the author of that book. He even signed a copy of it for me!"

So it is that the Christian must be able to say, "I know the author of my text book -- the Bible, and He has even signed His name where that text book knowledge is -- in my heart!" For God is an author, too. The Bible states that all scripture was inspired (or authored) by God so that we would be throughly furnished to all good works. (II Timothy 3:15-17)

It's so true that we need to be furnished through and through with all the good things of God: His salvation, His instructions from His text book, and the tools He gives us through the Baptism of the Holy Ghost. (I Corinthians 12:1-11 and 14: 1-5) We must place ourselves in a "classroom" of eager and productive fellow "students" (Hebrews 10: 24-25) --believers who work together in the unity of faith, and in the knowledge of the Son of God, who speak the truth in love that they might grow up into Him (Jesus) in all things, so that they are able to increase the body of Christ. (Ephesians 4: (13-16)


It is essential that we place ourselves under a "master teacher," a minister of the Word of God who has come under the discipline of God Himself. As God's people, we must submit ourselves to the righteousness of God (Romans 10:3) that we don't err by following our own understanding. (Proverbs 3:5)

With a combination like that, a Christian who is eager and willing can name his own goal – an eternity with the author of eternal salvation! (Hebrews 5:9) Others should be able to look upon us as being very special people when we walk from our "classroom" on Saturdays and Sundays with the proud comment, "I know the author – and the finisher – of my faith! (Hebrews 12:2) I know whom I have believed (II Timothy 1:12) and I have seen His works!"




in helping you fight your daily battles. "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path." (Ps 119:105) God's Word can be your guide in your everyday living, as well as your source of joy. (Ps 119:167) And the Bible is more current and up-to-date than the things you read in newspapers. It is for the believers today. Most important of all, God's Word doesn't lie or is not full of untruths. If God says He will do a certain thing, you can rest assured, knowing that it will be done.

BENEFITS OF STUDYING GOD'S WORD

Did you know that you can be healed through reading and studying God's Word? "He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions." (Ps. 107:20) By reading God's Word, you can be completely set free (John 8:32), you can gain understanding (Ps 119:130), your heart can rejoice and be joyful in the midst of persecution (Jer 15:16). By hearing God's Word, you can have more faith. "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." (Rom 10:17) Perhaps most important of all, the Scriptures can make you wise unto salvation. "And that from a child, thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works." 
